Sub-tables covering municipal minutes (from Shawnee Commission, Airport Authority, Municipal Authority, and American Legion Baseball) have been refined to support deeper financial and operational analysis.

Detailed comparisons between manual and AI-imported datasets are under review to assess discrepancies and validate financial figures, which are crucial for understanding revenue trends in youth sports.
