Executive Overview

The source report identifies **Kim Hatcher** under the displayed USSSA classification **Area Director** and reports **\$60,480 in total Calculated Team Entry Fees**, all categorized as softball. It also displays 378 in the Teams field, 24 divisions, a Minimum Games Played value of **-1**, and **0 Minimum Required Officials**.

This profile requires a materially different interpretation from the conventional tournament-director profiles in the Hidden Valley dataset. 2024 - \$23,040 is the largest displayed season, approximately 38.1% of the \$60,480 total. It is followed by **2023 - \$19,840** and **2025 - \$17,600**. The 2026 chart value is **\$0**.

The \$0 value for 2026 should not automatically be interpreted as proof that no tryout, camp, registration, or other operational activity occurred. It means the public data captured in this particular Calculated Team Entry Fee field contributes \$0 for that season. Additional records would be required to determine the underlying 2026 activity.

The report shows complete geographic concentration in **Choctaw, Oklahoma County**, with **Bouse Sports Complex - \$60,480** as the sole facility category. This distinction is important for both methodological accuracy and public presentation. Applying a normal tournament-host narrative to this profile would overstate what the underlying records and supplied context establish.

USSSA Classification and Organizational Context

Page 2 of the source report provides generic USSSA organizational context. It depicts **USSSA National -> State Director -> Area Director -> Tournament Director -> Tournament/Event -> Teams** and states that Tournament Directors at the state level and below are classified by USSSA as Area Directors. It also states that USSSA appointees generally operate as independent contractors rather than employees.

For Kim Hatcher, the displayed classification remains **Area Director**. However, the supplied context indicates that her functional Oklahoma role for this activity is tied to All American Games tryouts rather than conventional tournament hosting. The generic Page 2 hierarchy should therefore not be used to infer that Kim Hatcher personally performed every function described in the Tournament Director box.

Applicable Online Payment Structure - Evidentiary Limits

Page 2 also depicts an applicable online payment pathway: **Teams -> USSSA Online Payment System -> USSSA -> ACH Transfer -> Event/Fiscal Director -> Tournament Operations**. The infographic summarizes USSSA documentation concerning applicable online event-payment processing.

The source report does not establish the exact payment pathway used for Kim Hatcher's All American Games tryout/camp registrations, who ultimately received each camper fee, what portion was retained by USSSA, whether any amount was transmitted to a local director, or how the funds were subsequently used. Those questions require program-specific registration, payment, ACH, contract, accounting, or other records.

The subsequent disposition of the \$60,480 in Calculated Team Entry Fee activity cannot be determined from this dataset alone.

What This Profile Establishes

Source-report findings: Kim Hatcher; displayed Area Director classification; \$60,480 total Calculated Team Entry Fees; \$0 baseball; \$60,480 softball; 378 in the source Teams field; 24 divisions; -1 Minimum Games Played; 0 Minimum Required Officials; seasons 2023-2026; Choctaw; Oklahoma County; and Bouse Sports Complex.

It also does not independently establish the exact Florida venue, dates, selection criteria, number of Oklahoma athletes ultimately selected, or their subsequent participation in the All American Games. Those matters would require additional All American Games program records or other independent documentation.

The methodology does not fill these evidentiary gaps with assumptions.

Director-Specific Conclusion

Kim Hatcher's profile is analytically distinct from the standard Oklahoma USSSA tournament-director model. The source report identifies **\$60,480 in softball Calculated Team Entry Fees** across the displayed 2023-2026 seasons, with all nonzero calculated activity associated with **Choctaw / Oklahoma County / Bouse Sports Complex**. Yet the report simultaneously displays **-1 Minimum Games Played** and **0 Minimum Required Officials**.

When read together with the supplied All American Games context, these characteristics support treating the Oklahoma activity as a **tryout/camp participation profile** rather than a conventional tournament-host profile. Kim Hatcher is associated with the Oklahoma tryout stage for a broader USSSA All American Games program whose annual games are described as taking place in Florida.

This distinction should be maintained in future landing pages, executive summaries, dashboards, and comparative director analysis so that Kim Hatcher is not inaccurately grouped with Area Directors whose Oklahoma records reflect locally hosted tournaments, scheduled games, and officiating requirements.
