Hello,

I am providing the attached **Hidden Valley - Integrity of the Game USSSA Facility Report for Lions Club Ballfields**. This report is part of the Hidden Valley Oklahoma USSSA Research Dataset covering 2001-2026 and organizes publicly available USSSA tournament and league information into a consistent facility-level analytical framework.

For this facility, the report contains **direct / stand-alone Primary Facility activity only**. No satellite or multi-facility activity was identified for Lions Club Ballfields in the report population, so there is no separate satellite-activity population or combined Page 4 footprint to analyze. This is an important facility-specific distinction: the documented activity summarized below is attributable to records listing Lions Club Ballfields independently.

How the Financial Measure Is Developed

Number of Participating Teams x Publicly Posted Team Entry Fee = Calculated Team Entry Fees. The calculation is performed at the applicable event-record level and then aggregated for analysis. These figures are analytical measurements derived from public USSSA information and are not, by themselves, proof of actual collections, gross receipts, facility income, municipal revenue, tournament-director compensation, profit, taxable income, gate or concession revenue, distributions, or disposition of funds.

Pages 1-2 - Direct / Stand-Alone Lions Club Ballfields Activity

The direct Primary Facility population contains records identifying **Lions Club Ballfields** independently as the event facility. The report identifies **\$98,842** in Calculated Team Entry Fees, consisting of **\$94,211 in baseball** and **\$4,631 in softball**. The population represents **22 teams**, **52 minimum games**, and **3,200 minimum officials**. It identifies one facility, one municipality, and one county. The municipality shown is **Shawnee**.

League activity is not established in the report: the League Teams scorecard states **No data**, while League Team Entry Fees are displayed as **\$0.00**. Consistent with the Hidden Valley methodology, a \$0.00 public listing should not be converted into an unsupported fee or treated as proof that no operational activity occurred.

Tournament Director Activity

The Page 1 director chart displays three named director categories: **Scott Nelson - \$61.38K**, **Ted Cox - \$26.39K**, and **Kenneth Crawford - \$11.07K**. These amounts describe Calculated Team Entry Fee activity associated with the displayed director categories; they do not establish personal receipts or compensation.

Data-quality note: the report's Director(s) scorecard displays 2, while the director chart visibly contains three named director categories. Because the source report contains this internal inconsistency, this summary preserves both observations rather than silently correcting or reconciling them. The underlying dataset should be reviewed if an exact unique-director count is required.

Annual / Sport Trend Analysis

The total annual Calculated Team Entry Fee series shown is: **2008 \$6.60K; 2007 \$36.51K; 2006 \$19.89K; 2005 \$9.80K; 2004 \$19.78K; 2003 \$6.02K; and 2002 \$243.** The highest displayed total season is **2007 at \$36.51K.**

The baseball series is: **2008 \$6.60K; 2007 \$31.88K; 2006 \$19.89K; 2005 \$9.80K; 2004 \$19.78K; 2003 \$6.02K; and 2002 \$243.** The highest displayed baseball season is **2007 at \$31.88K.**

Softball activity is displayed only for **2007 at \$4.63K.** This matches the report's overall softball Calculated Team Entry Fee total of \$4,631.

No Satellite / Multi-Facility Activity Identified

Unlike facilities with documented multi-site event combinations, the Lions Club Ballfields report contains **no satellite or multi-facility activity population to report.** Accordingly, there are no facility-combination totals, satellite municipalities, satellite directors, or separate combined-footprint calculations presented for this facility. The facility's documented report population is therefore the direct stand-alone activity summarized on Pages 1-2.

The general facility methodology still distinguishes direct activity from associated multi-facility activity and applies the principle **Association is not allocation.** For Lions Club Ballfields, however, no associated multi-facility population was identified in this report, so that allocation issue does not arise in the facility-specific calculations presented here.

Methodology & Interpretation

The Hidden Valley dataset is an independent research reconstruction based primarily on publicly accessible USSSA event, tournament, league, director, facility, team, pricing, and related historical information. The underlying records may contain omissions, naming variations, reused or inconsistent identifiers, facility-name changes, \$0.00 listings, missing fields, or later revisions. The methodology records what the public information supports and does not fill evidentiary gaps with unsupported assumptions.

Calculated Team Entry Fees measure the analytical relationship between publicly documented participation and publicly posted pricing. They do not independently establish collection, receipt, distribution, ownership, profit, tax treatment, or disposition of funds.

Key Takeaway

The Lions Club Ballfields facility report documents a relatively concentrated historical USSSA activity profile centered in Shawnee. The direct stand-alone population identifies **\$98,842** in Calculated Team Entry Fees associated with **22 teams**, with the activity overwhelmingly baseball-related: **\$94,211 baseball** compared with **\$4,631 softball.** The highest displayed season is 2007, and no satellite or multi-facility activity was identified for this facility report. As a result, the direct stand-alone population is also the complete documented facility activity population available for this analysis.
