Evidentiary rule: Calculated Team Entry Fees are Number of Participating Teams x Publicly Posted Team Entry Fee. They are not, by themselves, proof of actual collections, facility or municipal revenue, director compensation, profit, taxable income, or disposition of funds.

Executive Summary

The report identifies **Love Hatbox Field** as the Primary Facility. Stand-alone records display **\$1,018,614.00** in Calculated Team Entry Fees: **\$943,318.00 baseball** and **\$75,296.00 softball**. The direct population contains **6,520 teams**, **14,926 minimum games**, **1,074,760 minimum officials** as displayed, three directors, one municipality, and one county. League activity includes **498 league teams** and **\$7,235.00** in League Team Entry Fees.

Director and Municipality Concentration

The direct municipality chart is entirely associated with **Muskogee**. The director chart is led by **Marie Gassaway at approximately \$957.78K**, followed by Neil Hays (\$44.70K) and Ted Cox (\$16.14K). These values describe Calculated Team Entry Fee activity associated with the records and are not findings of director income, compensation, or receipt of funds.

The highest displayed total season is **2008 at \$145.87K**. The highest displayed baseball season is also 2008 at **\$128.21K**. The highest displayed softball season is **2016 at \$26.04K**. The report displays \$0 total activity for 2014 and 2001; these public \$0.00 values should not be replaced with unsupported estimates.

League Activity

The direct population includes **498 league teams** and **\$7,235.00** in displayed League Team Entry Fees. As with tournament calculations, these figures measure documented participation and publicly displayed pricing and do not independently establish collections or disposition of funds.

Associated Multi-Facility / Satellite Activity

Page 3 excludes the stand-alone Love Hatbox Field population and identifies one multi-facility configuration: **Love Hatbox Field + Sallisaw Sports Complex**. The associated population displays **\$3,885.00** in Calculated Team Entry Fees, entirely softball, with 18 teams, 47 minimum games, 3,760 minimum officials, one displayed facility-combination category, one director, one municipality category, and one county category.

Association is not allocation. The \$3,885.00 is one pool of Calculated Team Entry Fee activity associated with records identifying Love Hatbox Field and Sallisaw Sports Complex together. The report does not establish how teams, games, officials, fees, or other activity were divided between those locations.

Combined Documented Facility Activity Footprint

Page 4 combines direct stand-alone records with the associated multi-facility population. The broadest documented footprint is **\$1,022,499.00** in Calculated Team Entry Fees: **\$943,318.00 baseball** and **\$79,181.00 softball**. It contains **6,538 teams**, **14,973 minimum games**, **1,078,520 minimum officials**, two facility/facility-combination categories, four directors, two municipality categories, and two counties.

The combined facility chart is dominated by stand-alone Love Hatbox Field at approximately \$1.02M, with the Love Hatbox Field + Sallisaw Sports Complex configuration at \$3.89K. The municipality chart similarly displays Muskogee at approximately \$1.02M and Muskogee/Sallisaw at \$3.89K. The combined director chart is led by Marie Gassaway (\$957.78K), followed by Neil Hays (\$44.70K), Ted Cox (\$16.14K), and Chris Johnson (\$3.89K).

Methodology & Evidentiary Interpretation

Pages 1-2: direct records listing Love Hatbox Field independently. **Page 3:** associated activity where Love Hatbox Field appears with Sallisaw Sports Complex. **Page 4:** the combined documented footprint. Page 4 is not proof that every dollar, team, game, or official occurred exclusively at Love Hatbox Field.

Calculated Team Entry Fees are developed by multiplying documented participating teams by the publicly posted Team Entry Fee at the applicable event-record level. They are analytical measures of documented activity, not verified revenue, profit, compensation, taxable income, bank deposits, gate/concession receipts, or audited financial results. Separate facility reports should not simply be summed because multi-facility events can appear in more than one facility report; statewide aggregation requires event-level deduplication.

Facility-Specific Synthesis

Love Hatbox Field has a documented direct USSSA activity population of **\$1,018,614.00** in Calculated Team Entry Fees across 6,520 teams, with baseball accounting for \$943,318.00 and softball \$75,296.00. The direct population is associated with Muskogee and is led in the director chart by Marie Gassaway. The report identifies 498 league teams and \$7,235.00 in League Team Entry Fees.

The highest displayed direct total season is 2008 at \$145.87K; 2008 is also the highest baseball season at \$128.21K, while 2016 is the highest displayed softball season at \$26.04K. Page 3 identifies a comparatively small associated multi-facility population of \$3,885.00 involving Love Hatbox Field + Sallisaw Sports Complex, entirely softball. Page 4 produces a combined documented footprint of **\$1,022,499.00** across 6,538 teams.

The associated configuration is subject to the report's controlling principle that association does not establish allocation. The public records establish that the two facilities were associated with the same event population but do not determine how the \$3,885.00, 18 teams, 47 minimum games, or 3,760 minimum officials were distributed between Love Hatbox Field and Sallisaw Sports Complex.
