Purpose, Scope and Methodology

This professional report summarizes the **Hidden Valley - Integrity of the Game USSSA Director Activity Profile for Lynn Gibson**. The Oklahoma USSSA Research Dataset (2001-2026) organizes publicly available USSSA activity into a consistent analytical framework covering sport, teams, divisions, minimum games, minimum required officials, Calculated Team Entry Fees, seasons, municipalities, counties, facilities, and organizational/payment context.

The broader Hidden Valley dataset includes both tournament and league activity. Some league records may document teams, divisions, dates, facilities and other operational information while displaying a **\$0.00 Team Entry Fee**. A \$0.00 publicly reported fee does not necessarily mean no operational activity occurred, and the methodology does not impute an unsupported fee.

Participating Teams x Publicly Posted Team Entry Fee = Calculated Team Entry Fees. These figures should not be interpreted as USSSA-reported aggregate revenue, director income, compensation, profit, taxable income, net proceeds or audited financial statements.

Lynn Gibson - Sport and Operational Breakdown

The report identifies **Lynn Gibson as a USSSA Area Director**. The profile displays **\$4,513,775 in Total Calculated Team Entry Fees**, with **\$4,513,775 in baseball** and **\$0 in softball**. A \$0 softball scorecard should not automatically be treated as proof that no softball-related operational record existed unless the underlying records establish that conclusion.

Operationally, the profile displays **22,977 teams**, **2,899 divisions of play**, **51,108 minimum games played**, and **91,003 minimum required officials**.

Among individually displayed years, **2022 is the largest at \$303,674**. The 2023-2026 values are tightly clustered near \$298,000-\$300,000. The "Others" category totals \$2,204,771; the individual years within that category cannot be determined from the profile page alone.

Bixby is the largest individually displayed municipality category at \$2,493,839, followed by Jenks at \$1,044,867. Combined municipality categories represent one geographic event classification and should not be duplicated across each municipality. These amounts identify geographic associations in the public records and should not be interpreted as municipal revenue.

Bentley Sports Complex - \$2,244,176 is the largest independently displayed facility category, followed by **Jenks Youth Baseball Complex - \$1,015,666**. Multi-facility categories represent one pool of Calculated Team Entry Fee activity associated with the combined facility configuration; the full amount should not be independently attributed to each facility.

Sand Springs Youth Baseball and Glenpool Sports Complex appear both independently and in combinations with other facilities. Those classifications should remain separate. The report also uses both **Bentley Sports Complex** and **Bentley Park Sports Complex**; those labels are preserved as displayed rather than silently merged.

The facility chart does not establish how Team Entry Fees were allocated among facilities, rental payments, revenue sharing, facility income, distributions, net proceeds, or subsequent disposition of event funds. Nor does the report establish that a secondary facility served as an overflow or satellite site unless independently documented.

Tulsa County is the dominant county category at \$4,066,292. This is consistent with the municipality and facility charts, which show major concentrations in Bixby, Jenks and other Tulsa-area locations. Multi-county categories are one combined geographic classification and should not be independently attributed in full to every county listed.

Rogers and Creek Counties also appear independently in addition to appearing within combined county classifications. Those categories should remain analytically separate rather than being automatically aggregated.

USSSA Organizational and Financial Structure

Page 2 provides organizational and payment-process context rather than additional Lynn Gibson-specific financial findings. The infographic depicts the general authority flow as **USSSA National -> State Director -> Area Director -> Tournament Director -> Tournament/Event -> Teams**.

The financial-flow portion depicts applicable online event payments as **Teams -> USSSA Online Payment System -> USSSA -> ACH -> Event/Fiscal Director -> Tournament Operations**. It describes an applicable online payment pathway and should not be interpreted as establishing that every tournament or league payment necessarily followed that exact pathway.

The subsequent disposition of event funds is not determined by the Hidden Valley dataset unless independently documented. The source disclaimer also states that the organizational and financial-flow graphics should not be interpreted as establishing ownership of funds, individual compensation, tax liability, legal liability, or ultimate disposition of tournament proceeds.

Lynn Gibson - Profile Summary

The report identifies **Lynn Gibson as a USSSA Area Director** and displays **\$4,513,775 in Total Calculated Team Entry Fees, all categorized as baseball**, associated with **22,977 teams, 2,899 divisions, 51,108 minimum games played, and 91,003 minimum required officials**.

Among individually displayed seasons, **2022 is the largest at \$303,674**, while the aggregated “Others” season category totals \$2,204,771. **Bixby is the largest individually displayed municipality category at \$2,493,839, Tulsa County is the dominant county category at \$4,066,292, and Bentley Sports Complex is the largest individually displayed facility category at \$2,244,176.**

The profile also contains meaningful multi-facility and multi-county classifications. These combined records should remain intact as one pool of Calculated Team Entry Fee activity associated with the applicable configuration rather than having the full amount duplicated across every location appearing in the record.
