Purpose, Scope and Methodology

This professional report summarizes the **Hidden Valley - Integrity of the Game USSSA Director Activity Profile for Marie Gassaway**. The Oklahoma USSSA Research Dataset (2001-2026) organizes publicly available USSSA activity into a consistent analytical framework covering sport, teams, divisions, minimum games, minimum required officials, Calculated Team Entry Fees, seasons, municipalities, counties, facilities, and USSSA organizational/payment context.

The broader Hidden Valley dataset includes tournament and league activity. Some league records may document teams, divisions, dates, facilities and other operational information while displaying a **\$0.00 Team Entry Fee**. A \$0.00 publicly reported fee does not necessarily mean no operational activity occurred, and the methodology does not impute an unsupported fee.

Participating Teams x Publicly Posted Team Entry Fee = Calculated Team Entry Fees. These figures should not be interpreted as USSSA-reported aggregate revenue, director income, personal compensation, profit, taxable income, net proceeds or audited financial statements.

Marie Gassaway - Sport and Operational Breakdown

The report identifies **Marie Gassaway as a USSSA Area Director**. The profile displays **\$1,687,371 in Total Calculated Team Entry Fees**, consisting of **\$1,643,240 in baseball** and **\$44,131 in softball**. The profile therefore contains Calculated Team Entry Fee activity associated with both sports.

Operationally, the profile displays **9,292 teams**, **1,436 divisions of play**, **19,989 minimum games played**, and **36,021 minimum required officials**.

Among individually displayed years, **2011 is the largest at \$134,802**, followed by 2012 at \$127,271 and 2010 at \$121,900. The "Others" category totals \$835,675; its individual years cannot be determined from the profile page alone. The chart measures Calculated Team Entry Fees rather than every form of operational activity.

Muskogee is the largest municipality category at \$957,781, followed by Tulsa at \$647,507. The Owasso / Tulsa category is one combined geographic classification and should not be duplicated across the individual municipalities. These amounts identify geographic associations in the public records and should not be interpreted as municipal revenue.

Love Hatbox Field - \$936,333 is the largest individually displayed facility category, followed by Tulsa Hilti Park - \$643,114. The report separately identifies Love Hatbox Sports Complex - \$21,448; that source label is preserved rather than automatically merged with Love Hatbox Field.

The visible facility chart does not show an obvious multi-facility combination among the individually displayed categories. Facility amounts identify the facility associated with the applicable event records; they do not establish facility receipts, rental payments, revenue sharing, facility income, distributions, net proceeds, or subsequent disposition of event funds.

Muskogee County is the largest county category at \$960,091, followed by Tulsa County at \$683,736. Rogers / Tulsa is a combined county classification and should not be independently attributed in full to both counties. The county findings align with the two dominant geographic/facility concentrations in Muskogee and Tulsa without establishing governmental revenue.

Geographic and Facility Concentration

The Page 1 charts reveal two dominant clusters of activity: **Muskogee / Muskogee County / Love Hatbox Field** and **Tulsa / Tulsa County / Tulsa Hilti Park**. This is a finding about the geographic and facility associations in the public USSSA records and Calculated Team Entry Fee analysis. It does not establish who ultimately received event funds.

Smaller amounts extend across Owasso, Jenks, Del City, Altus, Blackwell, Oklahoma City and additional locations represented within the “Others” categories.

USSSA Organizational and Financial Structure

Page 2 provides organizational and payment-process context rather than additional Marie Gassaway-specific financial findings. The infographic depicts the general authority flow as **USSSA National -> State Director -> Area Director -> Tournament Director -> Tournament/Event -> Teams**.

The financial-flow portion depicts applicable online event payments as **Teams -> USSSA Online Payment System -> USSSA -> ACH -> Event/Fiscal Director -> Tournament Operations**. This describes an applicable online payment pathway and should not be interpreted as establishing that every tournament or league payment necessarily followed that exact pathway.

The subsequent disposition of event funds is not determined by the Hidden Valley dataset unless independently documented. The source disclaimer also states that the organizational and financial-flow graphics should not be interpreted as establishing ownership of funds, individual compensation, tax liability, legal liability, or the ultimate disposition of tournament proceeds.

Marie Gassaway - Profile Summary

The report identifies **Marie Gassaway as a USSSA Area Director** and displays **\$1,687,371 in Total Calculated Team Entry Fees**, consisting of **\$1,643,240 in baseball** and **\$44,131 in softball**. The profile therefore documents calculated fee activity associated with both sports.

Operationally, the profile displays **9,292 teams, 1,436 divisions, 19,989 minimum games played, and 36,021 minimum required officials**. Among individually displayed seasons, **2011 is the largest at \$134,802**, while the aggregated "Others" category totals \$835,675.

Geographically, **Muskogee is the largest municipality category at \$957,781** and **Muskogee County is the largest county category at \$960,091**. Tulsa follows at \$647,507 by municipality and \$683,736 by county. At the facility level, **Love Hatbox Field is the largest individually displayed category at \$936,333**, followed by **Tulsa Hilti Park at \$643,114**.

The overall profile therefore shows two dominant geographic/facility concentrations - Muskogee / Love Hatbox Field and Tulsa / Tulsa Hilti Park - while preserving smaller activity associated with additional Oklahoma locations. These findings describe activity associations and Calculated Team Entry Fees; they do not establish personal income, facility revenue, or ultimate disposition of event funds.
