Executive Overview and State-Leadership Context

This profile concerns the **OK USSSA Fastpitch State Office**, rather than a named individual director. The source report displays the office in the USSSA Area Director field and associates it with Oklahoma fastpitch/softball activity. For this analysis, the office is treated as part of the **Oklahoma state-level softball leadership and administrative structure**, while preserving the report's exact displayed classification of **Area Director**.

This distinction matters. The profile should not be read as a personal financial profile of a single individual. It organizes publicly available USSSA activity associated with the state-office designation, including sport, teams, divisions, games, officials, seasons, municipalities, counties, facilities, and Calculated Team Entry Fees.

Calculated Team Entry Fee Methodology

Participating Teams x Publicly Posted Team Entry Fee = Calculated Team Entry Fees. Where a publicly available tournament or league record displays \$0.00, the dataset records \$0.00 rather than estimating or imputing an unsupported fee.

Calculated Team Entry Fees are analytical estimates derived from public USSSA information. They are not USSSA-reported aggregate revenue, personal income, compensation, profit, taxable income, net proceeds, or audited financial statements.

Financial and Operational Activity

Page 1 identifies **\$116,426 in total Calculated Team Entry Fees**. All displayed calculated activity is categorized as **softball - \$116,426**; baseball displays **\$0**. The profile identifies **362 teams, 37 divisions of play, 1,049 minimum games, and 1,997 minimum required officials**.

Because this is a state-office profile, these figures are best understood as activity associated with the **OK USSSA Fastpitch State Office designation** in the underlying records. They do not establish state-office revenue, compensation paid to state leadership, or money personally received by any officer or director.

Calculated Team Entry Fees by Season

2023 accounts for \$97,958, approximately 84% of the two-year calculated total, while 2024 accounts for \$18,468. The report therefore shows a substantial concentration in 2023. These figures measure Calculated Team Entry Fees, not necessarily all operational activity occurring during each season.

The largest municipality category is **Choctaw at \$29,070**, followed by Citizen Potawatomi Nation at \$25,650 and Owasso at \$19,494. The footprint is geographically distributed across multiple Oklahoma communities rather than concentrated in one municipality.

Choctaw, Citizen Potawatomi Nation - \$4,104 is a combined municipality classification and represents one pool of Calculated Team Entry Fee activity. The full \$4,104 should not be independently attributed to each component location. Municipality amounts are geographic associations and do not establish municipal or tribal revenue.

Bouse Sports Complex at \$29,070 is the largest single-facility category, followed by Firelake Ballfields at \$25,650 and Owasso Sports Park North at \$19,494. The profile demonstrates a broad facility footprint consistent with a state-office/state-leadership activity profile rather than a single local park concentration.

Two multi-facility categories require special treatment. **Midwest City MAC, Reed Baseball Complex - \$8,550** and **Bouse Sports Complex, Firelake Ballfields - \$4,104** each represent one pool associated with the combined event configuration. The full amount must not be duplicated across the component facilities.

Reed Baseball Complex also appears independently at \$4,968, which is separate from the \$8,550 Midwest City MAC / Reed Baseball Complex category. Likewise, Bouse Sports Complex and Firelake Ballfields each appear independently and also together in a \$4,104 combined configuration. The source does not establish how combined amounts were allocated among facilities.

Facility associations do not, by themselves, establish facility rental payments, revenue sharing, facility income, distributions, net proceeds, or subsequent disposition of event funds.

Oklahoma County at \$42,588 is the largest county category, narrowly exceeding Tulsa County at \$41,144. Pottawatomie County accounts for \$25,650, while Cleveland County accounts for \$2,940.

Oklahoma, Pottawatomie - \$4,104 is a combined county classification representing one pool of activity. It should not be duplicated and independently assigned in full to both counties. County amounts identify geographic associations and do not establish county revenue.

Tournament and League Activity / \$0.00-Fee Records

The Hidden Valley methodology includes both tournament and league play. Some league records may identify teams, divisions, dates, directors, facilities, locations, and other evidence of organized activity while displaying a **\$0.00 Team Entry Fee**.

\$0.00 in Calculated Team Entry Fees does not necessarily mean \$0.00 in documented operational activity. It means the public Team Entry Fee field did not identify a fee for that record. Additional records would be necessary to determine whether any local fee arrangement existed; the methodology does not assume or impute one.

Page 2 - Organizational Structure and State-Leadership Significance

Page 2 places the profile within the broader USSSA organizational framework: **USSSA National -> State Director -> Area Director -> Tournament Director -> Tournament/Event -> Teams**. The infographic describes State Directors as administering the USSSA program within the state, approving events, and overseeing Area Directors.

That organizational context is especially relevant to this profile because the profiled entity is the **OK USSSA Fastpitch State Office**. The state-office designation indicates an organizational/state-leadership context, while the report's own classification field remains Area Director. This report therefore distinguishes the **entity's state-office leadership context** from the **classification label displayed in the source data**.

Applicable Online Payment Pathway

The Page 2 infographic depicts an applicable online payment pathway as **Teams -> USSSA Online Payment System -> USSSA -> ACH Transfer -> Event/Fiscal Director -> Tournament Operations**. It describes USSSA documentation concerning applicable online event-payment processing.

The report does not establish that every payment associated with the OK USSSA Fastpitch State Office necessarily followed this pathway. Nor does the pathway establish who ultimately retained funds, how funds were allocated, compensation, tax treatment, expenses, profit, or legal ownership.

Critical evidentiary limitation: the subsequent disposition of event funds is not determined by the Hidden Valley dataset unless independently documented.

What This State-Office Profile Establishes - and What It Does Not

Publicly Documented / Calculated: an OK USSSA Fastpitch State Office profile displayed in the Area Director field; \$116,426 in Calculated Team Entry Fees; softball activity; 362 teams; 37 divisions; 1,049 minimum games; 1,997 minimum required officials; 2023-2024 season activity; multiple municipalities, counties, facilities, and combined geographic/facility categories.

Organizational Context: Page 2 documents the USSSA National, State Director, Area Director, Tournament Director, event, and team hierarchy. The state-office name provides state-leadership context, but the source report itself displays Area Director as the classification.

Not Established: state-office revenue, personal income of any state director or Area Director, compensation, profit, taxable income, facility revenue, allocation of multi-facility proceeds, ownership of funds, or ultimate disposition of event funds.

\$0.00-Fee Limitation: where applicable underlying records display \$0.00, documented operational activity may still exist. No unsupported local fee is assumed.

The methodology does not fill evidentiary gaps with assumptions.

State-Leadership Profile Conclusion

The OK USSSA Fastpitch State Office profile is materially different from an individual local-director profile. It represents a **state-office designation associated with Oklahoma fastpitch/softball leadership activity** across a geographically dispersed footprint. The report identifies **\$116,426 in total Calculated Team Entry Fees**, all categorized as softball, together with **362 teams, 37 divisions, 1,049 minimum games, and 1,997 minimum required officials**.

The calculated activity is concentrated in **2023 at \$97,958**, with \$18,468 in 2024. The largest municipality category is **Choctaw at \$29,070**; the largest county category is **Oklahoma County at \$42,588**; and the largest single-facility category is **Bouse Sports Complex at \$29,070**. The profile also includes combined municipality, county, and facility categories that must remain single pools rather than being duplicated across their components.

Most importantly, the state-office label should be preserved as an organizational context, not converted into an unsupported financial conclusion. The \$116,426 is a calculated measure of activity associated with applicable public USSSA records; it does not establish revenue received by the Oklahoma state office, compensation to state leadership, or money personally received by any individual.
