Executive Overview

This report presents the **Hidden Valley - Integrity of the Game USSSA Director Activity Profile for Rick Glasser**. It applies the standardized Oklahoma USSSA Research Dataset (2001-2026) methodology to publicly available activity associated with Rick Glasser, including sport, teams, divisions, minimum games, minimum required officials, Calculated Team Entry Fees, seasons, municipalities, counties, facilities, and USSSA organizational/payment context.

The source report identifies **Rick Glasser as a USSSA Area Director**. The profile is overwhelmingly baseball-associated: \$6,849,950 of the \$6,852,785 Total Calculated Team Entry Fees is categorized as baseball, while \$2,835 is categorized as softball.

Quantitative Activity Snapshot

Operationally, the profile displays **23,976 teams, 2,388 divisions of play, 61,435 minimum games played, and 119,577 minimum required officials**. These operational measures should be analyzed separately from the Calculated Team Entry Fee measurement.

Tournament, League & \$0.00-Fee Methodology

The Hidden Valley dataset includes both tournament and league activity. Some league records may document teams, divisions, dates, directors, facilities, locations and other operational information while displaying a **\$0.00 Team Entry Fee**. A \$0.00 public Team Entry Fee means the public USSSA information captured did not identify a Team Entry Fee for that record; it does not necessarily mean no operational activity occurred.

\$0.00 in Calculated Team Entry Fees does not necessarily mean \$0.00 in documented operational activity. The methodology records \$0.00 rather than estimating an unsupported fee and does not state that locally administered fees were collected unless supporting documentation establishes that fact.

2026 is the largest individually displayed season at \$606,933, followed closely by 2025 at \$598,209. "Other Seasons" totals \$2,599,489 and is an aggregate of additional seasons, not one individual season. \$0.00-fee records may contribute operational activity without increasing the seasonal dollar totals.

Ardmore is the largest individually displayed municipality classification at \$1,096,337, followed by Tulsa at \$869,768 and Owasso at \$719,160. "Others" is an aggregate of additional municipality activity. These amounts identify geographic associations in event records and should not be characterized as municipal revenue.

O'Brien Park is the largest individually displayed named facility category at \$783,001, followed by Ardmore Youth Baseball at \$527,121 and Ardmore Regional Park at \$504,080. The \$3,370,829 "Others" category is an aggregate of additional facility activity and cannot be treated as one facility.

The visible facility chart primarily displays single-facility classifications. Under the Hidden Valley master methodology, any underlying multi-facility records must remain intact as one event-level pool and must not be duplicated across every facility. Facility data does not establish rental payments, revenue sharing, facility income, allocation of entry fees, distributions, net proceeds, or subsequent disposition of event funds.

Tulsa County is the largest individually displayed county classification at \$1,860,579, followed by Oklahoma County at \$1,601,887 and Carter County at \$1,096,337. Multi-county classifications remain intact as combined geographic pools and are not independently assigned in full to every county named.

Geographic & Facility Concentration

The profile shows substantial geographic dispersion but also several clear concentrations. Carter County's \$1,096,337 matches Ardmore's municipality total, while O'Brien Park, Ardmore Youth Baseball, and Ardmore Regional Park are major individually displayed facility classifications. Tulsa and Oklahoma Counties also account for substantial portions of the displayed county activity. These relationships support geographic concentration findings but do not establish who ultimately received event proceeds.

Page 2 - USSSA Organizational Structure

Page 2 provides contextual organizational information rather than another Rick Glasser-specific financial statement. It depicts the general authority flow as **USSSA National -> State Director -> Area Director -> Tournament Director -> Tournament/Event -> Teams**.

The graphic describes USSSA National as establishing rules, policies, procedures and State Director appointments; State Directors as administering programs within a state and overseeing Area Directors; Area Directors as USSSA appointees/independent contractors operating within a defined jurisdiction; Tournament Directors as managing sanctioned events; and teams as registering and paying applicable event fees.

Page 2 - Applicable Online Payment Flow

The financial-flow graphic depicts an applicable online event-payment pathway as **Teams -> USSSA Online Payment System -> USSSA -> ACH -> Event/Fiscal Director -> Tournament Operations**. It is explanatory context and should not be interpreted to mean every tournament or league payment necessarily followed that exact pathway.

The subsequent disposition of event funds is not determined by the Hidden Valley dataset unless independently documented. The organizational/payment material does not establish ownership of funds, individual compensation, tax liability, legal liability, or ultimate disposition of tournament proceeds.

Rick Glasser - Director-Specific Summary

The report identifies **Rick Glasser as a USSSA Area Director** and displays **\$6,852,785 in Total Calculated Team Entry Fees**, consisting of **\$6,849,950 baseball and \$2,835 softball**.
