Executive Overview

The profile identifies **TJ Millus** as a **USSSA Area Director**. It organizes publicly available USSSA activity within the Hidden Valley — Integrity of the Game Oklahoma USSSA Research Dataset (2001–2026), including tournament and league activity, sport, teams, divisions, games, officials, seasons, Calculated Team Entry Fees, municipalities, counties, facilities, and organizational/payment documentation.

This is a **USSSA Director Activity Profile**, not a revenue, income, compensation, profit, or tax report.

Calculated Team Entry Fee Methodology

Participating Teams × Publicly Posted Team Entry Fee = Calculated Team Entry Fees. When a public tournament or league record displays a \$0.00 Team Entry Fee, the dataset records \$0.00 rather than estimating an unsupported fee. \$0.00 in Calculated Team Entry Fees does not necessarily mean \$0.00 in documented operational activity.

Sport and Operational Activity

The report identifies **\$151,075** in total Calculated Team Entry Fees, all categorized as **softball**; baseball displays **\$0**. It also identifies **258 teams**, **19 divisions of play**, **850 minimum games**, and **1,700 minimum required officials**. The \$0 baseball figure alone does not establish an absence of all baseball operational activity because a record can report a \$0.00 Team Entry Fee.

Choctaw at \$63,750 is the largest municipality category. **Moore / Citizen Potawatomi Nation — \$16,875** is a combined classification representing one pool of activity; the amount must not be duplicated and independently assigned in full to both locations. These amounts identify geographic associations and do not establish municipal or tribal revenue.

Oklahoma County at \$66,390 is the largest county category. **Cleveland / Pottawatomie — \$16,875** is likewise one combined county classification and must not be duplicated across the individual counties.

Bouse Sports Complex at \$48,750 is the largest single-facility category, followed by **Buck Thomas Park at \$39,060**. The report also contains three multi-facility configurations. Each combined amount represents one pool of Calculated Team Entry Fee activity associated with that configuration.

Buck Thomas Park / FireLake Ballfields — \$16,875, Buck Thomas Park / Moore High School — \$15,625, and Bouse Sports Complex / Buck Thomas Sports Complex — \$15,000 must not be duplicated across the individual facilities. The source report does not establish how those combined amounts were allocated.

FireLake Ballfields also appears independently at \$13,125, separate from the Buck Thomas Park / FireLake Ballfields category. Bouse Sports Complex likewise appears independently at \$48,750 and separately in the Bouse Sports Complex / Buck Thomas Sports Complex configuration at \$15,000. Facility data does not establish rental payments, revenue sharing, facility income, distributions, net proceeds, or subsequent disposition of event funds.

Page 2 — USSSA Organizational & Financial Structure

Page 2 provides contextual organizational and payment information rather than additional TJ Millus-specific financial findings. The infographic depicts the authority flow as **USSSA National → State Director → Area Director → Tournament Director → Tournament/Event → Teams**. It states that Tournament Directors at the state level and below are classified by USSSA as Area Directors and that USSSA appointees generally operate as independent contractors rather than employees.

Applicable Online Payment Pathway

The infographic depicts an applicable online event-payment pathway as **Teams → USSSA Online Payment System → USSSA → ACH Transfer → Event/Fiscal Director → Tournament Operations**. This describes USSSA documentation concerning applicable online event-payment processing. The report does not establish that every tournament or league payment associated with TJ Millus necessarily followed this pathway.

Critical limitation: The subsequent disposition of event funds is not determined by the Hidden Valley dataset unless independently documented. The graphic does not establish ownership of funds, individual compensation, tax liability, legal liability, expenses, profit, or ultimate disposition of tournament proceeds.

What the Profile Establishes — and What It Does Not

Publicly documented activity: directors, teams, divisions, sports, seasons, facilities and facility combinations, municipalities and municipality combinations, counties and county combinations, tournaments/events, leagues where documented, and related operational information.

Calculated financial activity: participating teams multiplied by publicly posted Team Entry Fees where a fee is identified.

\$0.00-fee activity: documented tournament or league activity can exist even when the publicly available Team Entry Fee reports \$0.00; no unsupported fee is imputed.

Unknown financial activity: potential locally administered fees, refunds, discounts, expenses, distributions, compensation, net proceeds, tax treatment, allocations among facilities, and ultimate disposition of event funds cannot be established unless independently documented.

Director-Specific Conclusion

The profile identifies **TJ Millus as a USSSA Area Director** associated with **\$151,075 in total Calculated Team Entry Fees**, all categorized as softball, while baseball displays \$0. The profile identifies **258 teams, 19 divisions, 850 minimum games, and 1,700 minimum required officials**.

The largest season is **2024 at \$71,250**. The largest municipality category is **Choctaw at \$63,750**; the largest county category is **Oklahoma County at \$66,390**; and the largest single-facility category is **Bouse Sports Complex at \$48,750**. The profile materially differs from a single-location profile because it contains combined municipality, county, and facility categories that must remain intact as single pools rather than being duplicated across their component locations.

These figures represent Calculated Team Entry Fee activity associated with applicable publicly available USSSA records. They do not establish that TJ Millus personally received \$151,075 or that any municipality, county, tribal entity, or facility received the corresponding displayed amounts.
