Executive Overview

The source profile identifies **TJ Williams - OK FP** under the displayed classification **USSSA Area Director**. It reports **\$67,108 in total Calculated Team Entry Fees**, 598 teams, 81 divisions, 1,249 minimum games, and 2,057 minimum required officials.

For this research treatment, TJ Williams - OK FP is additionally being examined in the supplied project context as **part of Oklahoma USSSA softball state-director/state-leadership operations**. That context is analytically important, but the attached source report itself displays the classification Area Director. This PDF therefore preserves the source classification rather than substituting an unsupported formal title.

Leadership-context distinction: project context associates this director with Oklahoma USSSA softball state leadership; the attached report's displayed classification remains Area Director.

Why the State-Leadership Context Matters

Page 2 places State Directors and Area Directors within a USSSA organizational hierarchy. It depicts USSSA National appointing State Directors; State Directors administering the program within the state, approving events, and overseeing Area Directors; and Area Directors operating within the jurisdiction defined by the State Director.

This makes the profile relevant to a broader examination of Oklahoma USSSA Fastpitch governance and event administration. The profile alone does not establish TJ Williams's exact formal state-office title, appointment dates, supervisory authority, compensation, or specific decision-making responsibilities. Those matters require independent documentation.

Tournament and League Activity

The Hidden Valley Oklahoma USSSA Research Dataset includes both tournament play and league play. Some league records can document teams, divisions, dates, directors, locations, facilities, and other operational information while displaying a **\$0.00 Team Entry Fee**. Such records remain relevant because \$0.00 in publicly reported Team Entry Fees does not necessarily mean that no documented operational activity occurred.

The attached two-page profile does not separately quantify tournament-versus-league activity for TJ Williams - OK FP, so no director-specific allocation between the two is inferred.

Calculated Team Entry Fee Methodology

Participating Teams x Publicly Posted Team Entry Fee = Calculated Team Entry Fees. Where a public USSSA record displays \$0.00, the methodology records \$0.00 rather than estimating or imputing an unsupported fee.

Calculated Team Entry Fees are analytical measurements derived from public USSSA information. They are not USSSA-reported aggregate revenue, personal income, director compensation, profit, taxable income, net proceeds, or audited financial statements. The displayed **\$67,108** does not establish that TJ Williams personally received \$67,108.

Page 1 - Financial and Operational Analysis

The profile reports **\$67,108 total Calculated Team Entry Fees**, consisting of **\$66,476 baseball** and **\$632 softball**. This is a dual-sport profile in calculated-fee terms, although approximately 99.1% of the displayed total is categorized as baseball and approximately 0.9% as softball.

Operationally, the profile identifies **598 teams, 81 divisions, 1,249 minimum games, and 2,057 minimum required officials**. These measures describe documented scale independently of the Calculated Team Entry Fee measurement.

2008 - \$66,476 is the dominant season. **2016 - \$632** is the smaller component. The report therefore presents two separated points in time rather than a continuous annual series.

Moore - \$66,476 is the dominant municipality association, while **Durant - \$632** represents the smaller geographic component. The county dimension mirrors this concentration: **Cleveland County - \$66,476** and **Bryan County - \$632**. These are geographic associations and should not be characterized as municipal or county revenue.

Facility Analysis

Buck Thomas Park - \$66,476 is the dominant facility category, with **Durant Multi Sports Complex - \$632** separately categorized. No multi-facility configuration is displayed. Facility association does not establish facility rental payments, revenue sharing, facility income, distributions, net proceeds, or subsequent disposition of event funds.

Page 2 - USSSA Organizational and Financial Structure

Page 2 provides organizational and payment-flow context rather than additional TJ Williams-specific financial calculations. Its organizational authority flow depicts **USSSA National -> State Director -> Area Director -> Tournament Director -> Tournament/Event -> Teams**.

The State Director box describes state-level administration as administering the USSSA program within the state, approving events, and overseeing Area Directors. The Area Director box describes a USSSA appointee/independent contractor operating within the jurisdiction defined by the State Director and ensuring compliance with USSSA requirements. The report also states that Tournament Directors at the state level and below are classified by USSSA as Area Directors.

This generic hierarchy is relevant to the supplied state-leadership context for TJ Williams - OK FP, but it does not independently establish TJ Williams's exact formal title, appointment period, or scope of authority.

Applicable Online Payment Pathway

The Page 2 financial-flow infographic depicts an applicable pathway as **Teams -> USSSA Online Payment System -> USSSA -> ACH Transfer -> Event/Fiscal Director -> Tournament Operations**.

The graphic explains that teams may pay tournament entry fees during registration, applicable online payments are processed through USSSA's payment system, and USSSA documentation describes event funds being transmitted to the applicable director through ACH. It does not establish that every payment associated with TJ Williams - OK FP necessarily followed this pathway.

Critical evidentiary limitation: the subsequent disposition of event funds is not determined by the Hidden Valley dataset unless independently documented.

State-Leadership Research Significance

Within the larger Hidden Valley project, this profile is useful for examining governance and economic activity across organizational layers rather than simply ranking directors by calculated fees. The combination of the supplied state-leadership context, the report's Area Director classification, two geographic markets, two facilities, dual-sport calculated activity, and the Page 2 organizational hierarchy makes the profile relevant to questions about how Oklahoma USSSA Fastpitch operations were structured and administered.

The profile alone does not establish who approved specific events, who controlled facility agreements, who set entry fees, who received or retained particular payments, or whether TJ Williams supervised other directors. Appointment records, director agreements, event approvals, facility contracts, bank/ACH records, tax records, internal communications, or other independent documentation would be necessary to answer those questions.

What the Profile Establishes - and What It Does Not

Publicly displayed: TJ Williams - OK FP; Area Director classification; \$67,108 total Calculated Team Entry Fees; \$66,476 baseball and \$632 softball; 598 teams; 81 divisions; 1,249 minimum games; 2,057 minimum required officials; seasons 2008 and 2016; Moore and Durant; Cleveland and Bryan counties; Buck Thomas Park and Durant Multi Sports Complex.

Project context: TJ Williams - OK FP is being evaluated as part of Oklahoma USSSA softball state-director/state-leadership operations. This should be distinguished from the exact formal classification displayed in the source report.

Not established by this dataset alone: personal income, compensation, actual event profit, taxable income, exact state-office title or tenure, supervisory authority, facility revenue, allocation of proceeds, locally administered fees, or ultimate disposition of event funds.

The methodology does not fill evidentiary gaps with assumptions.

Director-Specific Conclusion

The Hidden Valley profile identifies **TJ Williams - OK FP** under the displayed classification **USSSA Area Director**, with **\$67,108 total Calculated Team Entry Fees: \$66,476 baseball and \$632 softball**. It identifies **598 teams, 81 divisions, 1,249 minimum games, and 2,057 minimum required officials**.

The calculated activity is highly concentrated in **2008 - \$66,476, Moore - \$66,476, Cleveland County - \$66,476, and Buck Thomas Park - \$66,476**, with a smaller 2016 component associated with **Durant / Bryan County / Durant Multi Sports Complex - \$632**.

Because the project is examining this director as part of **Oklahoma USSSA softball state leadership**, the profile should be considered alongside Page 2's organizational hierarchy and any independent documentation establishing the precise state-level role, appointment period, responsibilities, event-approval authority, or oversight relationships.
