Purpose, Scope and Methodology

This professional report summarizes the **Hidden Valley - Integrity of the Game USSSA Director Activity Profile for Terri Jungels**. The Oklahoma USSSA Research Dataset (2001-2026) organizes publicly available USSSA activity into a consistent analytical framework covering sport, teams, divisions, minimum games, minimum required officials, Calculated Team Entry Fees, seasons, municipalities, counties, facilities, and USSSA organizational/payment context.

The broader Hidden Valley dataset includes both tournament play and league play. Some league records may identify teams, divisions, dates, directors, facilities, locations and other operational information while displaying a **\$0.00 Team Entry Fee**. A \$0.00 publicly reported Team Entry Fee means the public USSSA information captured in the dataset did not identify a Team Entry Fee for that record; it does not necessarily mean no operational activity occurred.

The methodology does not assume that locally administered fees were collected and does not estimate or impute an unsupported fee. **\$0.00 in Calculated Team Entry Fees does not necessarily mean \$0.00 in documented operational activity.**

Participating Teams x Publicly Posted Team Entry Fee = Calculated Team Entry Fees. These amounts should not be interpreted as USSSA-reported aggregate revenue, director income, personal compensation, profit, taxable income, net proceeds, or audited financial statements.

Terri Jungels - Classification, Sport and Operational Scale

The source report identifies **Terri Jungels as a USSSA Area Director**. It states that Tournament Directors at the state level and below are classified by USSSA as Area Directors and that USSSA appointees generally operate as independent contractors rather than employees.

The profile displays **\$1,341,089 in Total Calculated Team Entry Fees**, all categorized as **baseball**, while the softball scorecard displays **\$0**. A \$0 sport scorecard should not automatically be interpreted as proving no operational activity existed in that sport unless the underlying records establish that conclusion.

Operationally, the profile displays **9,111 teams, 1,272 divisions of play, 19,499 minimum games played, and 33,835 minimum required officials**.

Among individually displayed seasons, **2014 is the largest at \$122,553**, followed by 2015 at \$119,709 and 2016 at \$107,545. The aggregated "Others" category totals \$568,796. The individual seasons included within that category cannot be determined from Page 1 alone. The chart measures Calculated Team Entry Fees rather than every form of operational activity.

Edmond is the dominant municipality category at \$1,154,651, while Stillwater is second at \$164,567. The **Edmond / Stillwater - \$17,918** category is one combined geographic classification and should not be duplicated across both municipalities. These amounts identify geographic associations in event records and should not be interpreted as municipal revenue.

The facility dimension contains both single-facility and multi-facility classifications. The largest displayed classification is **Hafer Park/A C Caplinger Sports Complex - \$926,919**. The report also separately displays **Hafer Park / A C Caplinger Sports Complex - \$209,078**. Because the source report presents these as separate labels, this analysis preserves them separately rather than silently merging them.

The **Airport East / Airport West / Babcock Park / Strickland Park - \$100,896** category represents one pool of Calculated Team Entry Fee activity associated with that four-facility configuration. It does not mean each facility independently represents \$100,896.

Likewise, **Hafer Park/A C Caplinger Sports Complex / Mitch Park - \$18,654** and the five-facility configuration totaling **\$17,918** are combined facility classifications. The full amount should not be duplicated across each facility. The source report does not establish which facility was primary or whether another facility served as overflow or satellite for those records.

Whittenberg Park, Bixby RBW Sports Complex and OKC Boomtown Ballyards appear as separately categorized activity. Facility data does not establish rental payments, revenue sharing, facility income, allocation of Team Entry Fees, distributions, net proceeds, or subsequent disposition of event funds.

Oklahoma County is the dominant county category at \$1,155,939, followed by Payne County at \$164,567. The **Oklahoma / Payne - \$17,918** category is one combined county classification and should not be independently attributed in full to both counties. Tulsa County appears separately at \$2,665.

Cross-Dimension Geographic and Facility Pattern

The profile shows a strong concentration of Calculated Team Entry Fee activity in the **Edmond / Oklahoma County** area, with substantial facility activity associated with Hafer Park/A C Caplinger Sports Complex and related facility configurations. **Stillwater / Payne County** forms the second major geographic concentration.

The matching **\$17,918** values appearing in the Edmond / Stillwater municipality classification, Oklahoma / Payne county classification, and the multi-facility configuration containing Hafer Park/A C Caplinger Sports Complex plus Airport East, Airport West, Babcock Park and Strickland Park indicate corresponding combined classifications in the summary report. Page 1 alone should not be used to infer additional event-level facts beyond those displayed classifications.

Page 2 - USSSA Organizational and Financial Structure

Page 2 provides organizational and payment-process context rather than additional Terri Jungels-specific financial findings. The infographic depicts the general organizational authority relationship as **USSSA National -> State Director -> Area Director -> Tournament Director -> Tournament/Event -> Teams**.

The graphic describes State Directors as administering USSSA programs within a state, Area Directors as USSSA appointees/independent contractors operating within a jurisdiction defined by the State Director, and Tournament Directors as managing sanctioned events. It reiterates that Tournament Directors at the state level and below are classified as Area Directors and that USSSA appointees generally operate as independent contractors rather than employees.

The financial-flow portion depicts an applicable online event-payment pathway as **Teams -> USSSA Online Payment System -> USSSA -> ACH -> Event/Fiscal Director -> Tournament Operations**. This is explanatory context concerning applicable online event-payment processing; the report does not establish that every tournament or league payment necessarily followed this pathway.

The subsequent disposition of event funds is not determined by the Hidden Valley dataset unless independently documented. The organizational and financial-flow graphics do not establish ownership of funds, individual compensation, tax liability, legal liability, or ultimate disposition of tournament proceeds.

Terri Jungels - Profile Summary

The report identifies **Terri Jungels as a USSSA Area Director** and displays **\$1,341,089 in Total Calculated Team Entry Fees, all categorized as baseball**, associated with **9,111 teams, 1,272 divisions, 19,499 minimum games played, and 33,835 minimum required officials**.

Among individually displayed seasons, **2014 is the largest at \$122,553**, while the aggregated "Others" category totals \$568,796. **Edmond is the dominant municipality category at \$1,154,651**, and **Oklahoma County is the dominant county category at \$1,155,939**. Stillwater and Payne County form the second major geographic concentration at \$164,567 each.

At the facility level, the report displays **Hafer Park/A C Caplinger Sports Complex - \$926,919** as the largest classification, while also separately displaying **Hafer Park / A C Caplinger Sports Complex - \$209,078**. Because the source uses different labels, they are preserved separately. Material multi-facility configurations include **Airport East / Airport West / Babcock Park / Strickland Park - \$100,896**, **Hafer Park/A C Caplinger Sports Complex / Mitch Park - \$18,654**, and the five-facility configuration totaling **\$17,918**.

These combined facility and geographic records remain intact as one pool of Calculated Team Entry Fee activity associated with the applicable configuration rather than having their full amounts duplicated across every facility, municipality, or county appearing in the record.

What This Report Ultimately Represents

This document should be understood as a **USSSA Director Activity Profile**, not simply a revenue report. It is designed to identify who was associated with the activity; the USSSA classification displayed; sport; teams and divisions; minimum games and officials; publicly posted Team Entry Fees where identified; Calculated Team Entry Fee activity; seasons; municipalities; counties; facilities and facility combinations; and the organizational/payment context described in USSSA materials.

The larger Hidden Valley project applies this methodology consistently across approximately 249 Oklahoma USSSA Director Activity Profiles so that tournament activity, league activity, sport, Calculated Team Entry Fees, \$0.00-fee activity, facilities, geographic concentration and operational scale can be evaluated using a common analytical framework.
