## USSSA Director Activity Profile - Executive Research Summary

### Executive Overview

The Hidden Valley - Integrity of the Game USSSA Director Activity Profile identifies **Tommy Carner** as a **USSSA Area Director**. The profile organizes publicly available USSSA activity into a consistent analytical framework covering sport, teams, divisions, minimum games, minimum required officials, seasons, municipalities, counties, facilities, and Calculated Team Entry Fees. The underlying Hidden Valley dataset includes both tournament and league activity and forms part of the Oklahoma USSSA Research Dataset (2001-2026).

### Methodology and Evidentiary Standard

**Calculated Team Entry Fees = Number of Participating Teams x Publicly Posted Team Entry Fee.** Where a publicly reported Team Entry Fee is \$0.00, the dataset records \$0.00 rather than estimating or imputing an unsupported fee. Therefore, \$0.00 in Calculated Team Entry Fees does not necessarily mean \$0.00 in documented operational activity.

Calculated Team Entry Fees are not represented as USSSA-reported aggregate revenue and should not be interpreted as director income, personal compensation, profit, taxable income, net proceeds, or audited financial statements. The methodology does not fill evidentiary gaps with assumptions.

### Sport and Operational Activity

The profile reports **\$192,349** in total Calculated Team Entry Fees, all categorized as **baseball**. Softball displays **\$0**. A zero calculated amount, standing alone, should not automatically be treated as proof that no operational activity existed because records with a publicly reported \$0.00 Team Entry Fee can still document operational activity.

The profile identifies **1,435 teams**, **246 divisions of play**, **3,225 minimum games played**, and **5,395 minimum required officials**. These measures describe operational scale separately from the Calculated Team Entry Fee measurement.

The largest season displayed is **2008 at \$38,567**, followed by 2009 at \$32,820 and 2005 at \$29,500. The season chart measures Calculated Team Entry Fees and does not necessarily capture all operational activity occurring in each year.

The profile shows a pronounced concentration in **Glenpool / Glenpool Sports Complex / Tulsa County**, associated with \$183,144 of the \$192,349 total. The remaining \$9,205 is associated with **Claremore / Claremore Youth Baseball Sports Complex / Rogers County**. These amounts identify geographic associations in applicable event records; they do not establish municipal revenue, facility income, rental payments, revenue sharing, or subsequent disposition of funds.

The facility chart presents Glenpool Sports Complex and Claremore Youth Baseball Sports Complex independently, rather than as a multi-facility grouping. The report states that tournament directors at the state level and below are classified by USSSA as Area Directors and that USSSA appointees generally operate as independent contractors rather than employees. The diagram describes relationships among national, state, area, tournament, event, and team levels.

The infographic describes USSSA documentation concerning an **applicable online event-payment process**: teams may pay tournament entry fees through the USSSA online payment system; applicable online payments are processed through USSSA; and documentation describes applicable event funds being transmitted by ACH to the Event/Fiscal Director. The profile does not establish that every tournament or league payment associated with Tommy Carner necessarily followed this pathway.

**Critical limitation: The subsequent disposition of event funds is not determined by the Hidden Valley dataset unless independently documented. **USSSA Organizational and Payment Documentation:** USSSA materials provide context concerning director classifications, independent-contractor status, and applicable online payment processing.

**Unknown Financial Activity:** Potential locally administered fees, refunds, discounts, expenses, distributions, compensation, net proceeds, tax treatment, and ultimate disposition of funds cannot be established from this profile unless independently documented.

## Director-Specific Conclusion

The profile identifies **Tommy Carner as a USSSA Area Director** associated with **\$192,349 in total Calculated Team Entry Fees**, all categorized as baseball. The underlying activity encompasses **1,435 teams, 246 divisions, at least 3,225 games, and 5,395 minimum required officials**. Activity spans 2003-2011, with **2008** representing the largest season at **\$38,567**.

The primary geographic and facility concentration is **Glenpool / Glenpool Sports Complex / Tulsa County** at \$183,144, followed by **Claremore / Claremore Youth Baseball Sports Complex / Rogers County** at \$9,205. These figures represent Calculated Team Entry Fee activity associated with applicable public USSSA records and do not establish that Tommy Carner personally received those amounts.

The larger Hidden Valley - Integrity of the Game project applies this methodology consistently across approximately 249 Oklahoma USSSA director profiles so that tournament activity, league activity, sport, Calculated Team Entry Fees, \$0.00-fee activity, facilities, geographic concentration, and operational scale can be evaluated through a common analytical framework.
