Executive Overview

This report presents the **Hidden Valley - Integrity of the Game USSSA Director Activity Profile for Top Gun Events**. It applies the standardized Oklahoma USSSA Research Dataset (2001-2026) methodology to publicly available activity associated with the profile, including sport, teams, divisions, minimum games, minimum required officials, Calculated Team Entry Fees, seasons, municipalities, counties, facilities, and USSSA organizational/payment context.

The source report identifies **Top Gun Events as a USSSA Area Director**. Its classification statement explains that Tournament Directors at the state level and below are classified by USSSA as Area Directors and that USSSA appointees generally operate as independent contractors rather than employees.

Quantitative Activity Snapshot

The source report displays **\$349,100 in Total Calculated Team Entry Fees**, consisting of **\$0 baseball** and **\$349,100 softball**. The \$0 baseball value is a calculated financial measurement; under the master methodology, it should not automatically be treated as proof that no baseball-related operational activity existed unless the underlying records establish that conclusion.

Operationally, the profile displays **545 teams, 30 divisions, 1,428 minimum games played, and 2,396 minimum required officials**. These measures document operational scale separately from the Calculated Team Entry Fee measurement.

Tournament, League & \$0.00-Fee Methodology

The Hidden Valley dataset is not limited to tournaments. It also contains USSSA league activity. Some league records may identify participating teams, divisions, league dates, directors, facilities, locations, and other evidence of activity while displaying a **\$0.00 Team Entry Fee**.

\$0.00 in Calculated Team Entry Fees does not necessarily mean \$0.00 in documented operational activity. A \$0.00 public Team Entry Fee means the captured public USSSA information did not identify a Team Entry Fee for that record. It could indicate no Team Entry Fee or another arrangement not visible in the public field; additional records would be necessary to determine what actually occurred.

Participating Teams x Publicly Posted Team Entry Fee = Calculated Team Entry Fees. Where the public Team Entry Fee is \$0.00, the dataset records \$0.00 rather than estimating or imputing an unsupported fee. Calculated Team Entry Fees should not be interpreted as USSSA-reported aggregate revenue, director income, personal compensation, profit, taxable income, net proceeds, or audited financial statements.

2019 is the largest displayed season at \$100,950, followed by 2018 at \$80,500, 2020 at \$69,850, 2017 at \$66,300, and 2021 at \$31,500. This chart measures Calculated Team Entry Fees by season and does not necessarily represent all operational activity occurring in a year.

Choctaw is the dominant municipality/location classification at \$239,750, followed by Oklahoma City at \$66,300, Citizen Potawatomi Nation at \$37,300, and Chickasha at \$5,750. These figures identify geographic associations in the event records and should not be characterized as municipal, tribal, or local-government revenue.

Bouse Sports Complex / FireLake Ballfields - \$125,000 is the largest displayed facility configuration and must be treated as one combined activity pool. It does not mean Bouse Sports Complex independently accounts for \$125,000 and FireLake Ballfields independently accounts for another \$125,000.

Bouse Sports Complex also appears independently at \$114,750, while **FireLake Ballfields appears independently at \$37,300**. Those are separately categorized records where each facility was identified without the other facility appearing in that particular facility grouping. The \$66,300 "Oklahoma City" entry is preserved exactly as displayed in the source report; the report does not provide a more specific facility name for that category.

The facility chart identifies facilities or facility combinations associated with applicable event records. It does not, by itself, establish how Team Entry Fees were allocated among facilities, facility rental payments, revenue sharing, facility income, distributions, net proceeds, or subsequent disposition of event funds.

Oklahoma County is the dominant county classification at \$306,050, followed by Pottawatomie County at \$37,300 and Grady County at \$5,750. The county distribution is consistent with the concentration shown in Choctaw/Oklahoma City and the Bouse Sports Complex-related facility records, without establishing that any county received these amounts.

Geographic & Facility Concentration

The source report shows a strong concentration in the Oklahoma County / Choctaw area. **Choctaw accounts for \$239,750** in the municipality dimension and **Oklahoma County accounts for \$306,050** in the county dimension. The largest facility classification is the combined **Bouse Sports Complex / FireLake Ballfields configuration at \$125,000**, followed by Bouse Sports Complex independently at \$114,750.

Operational Activity vs. Financial Measurement

The profile documents **545 teams across 30 divisions, at least 1,428 games, and 2,396 minimum required officials**. These operational measures answer a different question from the \$349,100 Calculated Team Entry Fee figure. A tournament or league record with a \$0.00 Team Entry Fee can contribute operational evidence while contributing \$0 to the calculated financial measurement.

Page 2 - USSSA Organizational Structure

Page 2 provides context rather than additional Top Gun Events-specific financial findings. The infographic depicts the organizational authority flow as **USSSA National -> State Director -> Area Director -> Tournament Director -> Tournament/Event -> Teams**.

The graphic describes USSSA National as establishing rules, policies, and procedures and appointing State Directors; State Directors as administering the USSSA program within the state, approving events, and overseeing Area Directors; Area Directors as USSSA appointees/independent contractors operating within a jurisdiction; Tournament Directors as managing sanctioned events; and teams as registering for events and paying applicable entry fees.

The infographic reiterates that Tournament Directors at the state level and below are classified by USSSA as Area Directors and that USSSA appointees generally operate as independent contractors rather than employees.

Page 2 - Applicable Online Payment Flow

The financial-flow portion of Page 2 depicts an applicable online event-payment pathway as **Teams -> USSSA Online Payment System -> USSSA -> ACH -> Event/Fiscal Director -> Tournament Operations**.

The graphic describes teams paying tournament entry fees during registration, applicable online payments being processed through USSSA's payment system, USSSA transmitting applicable funds through ACH, and an Event/Fiscal Director receiving funds for event operations. This is explanatory documentation concerning an applicable online event-payment process and should not be interpreted to mean every Top Gun Events tournament or league payment necessarily followed that exact pathway.

The subsequent disposition of event funds is not determined by the Hidden Valley dataset unless independently documented. The organizational/payment material does not establish ownership of funds, individual compensation, tax liability, legal liability, or ultimate disposition of tournament proceeds.

Top Gun Events - Director-Specific Summary

The report identifies **Top Gun Events as a USSSA Area Director** and displays **\$349,100 in Total Calculated Team Entry Fees**, consisting of **\$0 baseball and \$349,100 softball**. Operationally, the profile represents **545 teams, 30 divisions, 1,428 minimum games played, and 2,396 minimum required officials**.

2019 is the largest displayed season at \$100,950. The primary municipality/location classification is **Choctaw at \$239,750**; the primary county is **Oklahoma at \$306,050**; and the largest facility configuration is **Bouse Sports Complex / FireLake Ballfields at \$125,000**. Because that facility entry contains two facilities, the \$125,000 remains one combined activity pool rather than being duplicated across both locations.

The \$0 baseball scorecard is a financial measurement under the report's methodology. It should not automatically be interpreted as proof that no baseball operational activity existed unless underlying records establish that conclusion. Likewise, any \$0.00-fee tournament or league records remain relevant to operational measurement even though they contribute \$0 to Calculated Team Entry Fees.

What This Report Ultimately Represents

This document should be understood as a **USSSA Director Activity Profile rather than simply a revenue report**. It combines calculated financial measurement with operational measurement: director classification; sport; tournament and league activity where documented; teams and divisions; minimum games and officials; publicly posted Team Entry Fees; Calculated Team Entry Fee activity; seasons; municipalities; counties; facilities and facility combinations; and USSSA organizational/applicable online-payment documentation.

The larger Hidden Valley project applies this standardized methodology across approximately **249 Oklahoma USSSA Director Activity Profiles** so that tournament activity, league activity, sport, Calculated Team Entry Fees, \$0.00-fee activity, facility use, geographic concentration, and operational scale can be evaluated using a common analytical framework.
