Executive Summary

The Brian Crawford Memorial Sports Complex in Seminole, Oklahoma is a seven-field, multi-use athletic complex created through a memorial fundraising effort and community partnerships. The facility history identifies Trojan Stadium, a 9,000-square-foot indoor training facility, multi-use artificial-turf fields, an adaptive field, a walking trail, lighting, press boxes and other amenities. The complex officially hosted its grand opening in October 2022.

The conservative stand-alone facility view identifies **\$52,539** in Calculated Team Entry Fees associated with records listing the Brian Crawford Memorial Sports Complex independently: **\$38,817 baseball** and **\$13,722 softball**. Those records identify **177 teams**, at least **465 games**, at least **930 officials**, four tournament directors, one municipality and one county. No league teams or league Calculated Team Entry Fees are displayed.

IMPORTANT: Calculated Team Entry Fees are a research measure based on participating teams x publicly posted entry fee. They are not, by themselves, verified facility revenue, director income, profit, collections, or funds received.

1. Direct / Stand-Alone Primary Facility Activity

The direct municipality chart places the stand-alone activity in Seminole. Director concentration is led by Rick Glasser at approximately \$34.53K, followed by BIG Show Productions at \$13.72K, Wally Fortuna at \$2.89K and Dalton Lewis at \$1.40K in Calculated Team Entry Fee activity. These are analytical concentrations, not findings of compensation or receipt.

2. Annual and Sport Trend

The highest displayed direct season is 2022 at approximately \$20.37K, entirely baseball in the chart. Softball appears in 2023 and 2024, peaking at approximately \$9.25K in 2023. The annual series then declines through the displayed 2025 and 2026 seasons. These charts measure Calculated Team Entry Fee activity and should not be read as a revenue trend.



3. Associated Multi-Facility / Satellite Activity

Page 3 excludes the stand-alone Primary Facility population and examines event records in which the Brian Crawford Memorial Sports Complex appears with one or more additional facilities. This associated population identifies **\$569,017** in Calculated Team Entry Fees, consisting of **\$294,726 baseball** and **\$274,291 softball**, with **1,131 teams**, at least **3,628 games**, at least **7,256 officials**, 30 facilities/facility combinations, three directors, 26 municipalities and 14 counties.

The largest Page 3 municipality grouping is Citizen Pottawatomini Nation + Seminole at approximately \$156.27K, followed by Midwest City + Seminole at approximately \$106.58K. Director-associated activity is concentrated with Rick Glasser (\$283.46K) and BIG Show Productions (\$274.29K), with Wally Fortuna (\$11.27K).

ASSOCIATION IS NOT ALLOCATION. A multi-facility record establishes association with the same event; it does not establish how teams, games, officials, entry fees or other activity were distributed among individual facilities. The full combination amount must not be assigned to the Brian Crawford Memorial Sports Complex or to any other component facility.

4. Combined Documented Activity Footprint

The combined view is the broadest documented footprint involving the Primary Facility. Rick Glasser accounts for approximately \$317.98K of the combined director-associated Calculated Team Entry Fee activity, BIG Show Productions approximately \$288.01K, Wally Fortuna \$14.16K and Dalton Lewis \$1.40K. This is not a claim that every dollar, team, game or official occurred exclusively at the Brian Crawford Memorial Sports Complex.

5. Facility History and Community Context



The facility history states that the complex was created in memory of Brian Crawford, a Prague High School senior and baseball player who died in a 2005 automobile accident after swerving to avoid another vehicle. A memorial fund developed into the Brian Crawford Memorial Foundation, which held an annual multi-state youth baseball tournament for more than 12 years and raised \$500,000 toward a permanent complex.

The history describes a partnership involving the Crawford Foundation, Seminole State College Educational Foundation, the Cal Ripken, Sr. Foundation and community leadership gifts. Groundbreaking and land clearing began in November 2019; the main initial construction phases concluded in December 2021; and the grand opening occurred in October 2022.

6. Methodology, Limitations and Interpretation

Calculated Team Entry Fees: Number of participating teams x publicly posted Team Entry Fee. A public \$0 fee remains \$0 in the dataset rather than being replaced with an assumed local fee. A \$0 listing does not necessarily establish that no operational activity occurred.

Direct vs. associated activity: Pages 1-2 measure records listing the Primary Facility alone. Page 3 measures associated multi-facility records excluding the stand-alone population. Page 4 combines those analytical populations into the broadest documented activity footprint.

Limitations: Historical public records may contain incomplete information, naming variations, reused or inconsistent identifiers, facility-name changes, zero-dollar listings and missing fields. Multi-facility records may not establish allocation among sites. Separate facility reports should therefore not simply be added together to create statewide totals; event-level deduplication is required.

Independent research disclaimer: The Hidden Valley dataset is an independent research reconstruction based primarily on publicly accessible USSSA information. It is not an official USSSA report or an audit, tax determination, forensic accounting conclusion or legal finding. Facility-Specific Synthesis

The Brian Crawford Memorial Sports Complex shows a relatively modest stand-alone USSSA footprint - \$52,539 in Calculated Team Entry Fees across 177 teams - but a substantially larger documented association with multi-site events. The Page 3 associated population reaches \$569,017 and the Page 4 combined footprint reaches \$621,556 across 1,308 teams, at least 4,093 games, at least 8,186 officials, 31 facilities/facility combinations, 26 municipalities and 14 counties. The distinction between direct activity and associated multi-facility activity is therefore essential to interpreting the facility's role accurately.
