Hidden Valley - Integrity of the Game USSSA Facility Activity Summary

Oklahoma USSSA Baseball & Softball Research | 2001-2026

Executive Summary

The Buck Thomas Park Facility Report documents historical USSSA baseball and softball activity associated with records listing Buck Thomas Park in Moore, Oklahoma. Pages 1-2 provide the conservative direct/stand-alone view, Page 3 separately identifies associated multi-facility activity, and Page 4 combines those populations into the broadest documented activity footprint.

The direct Primary Facility population identifies **\$2,199,228 in Calculated Team Entry Fees**: \$966,934 baseball and \$1,232,294 softball. It represents 14,497 teams, at least 41,643 games, 69,932 umpire assignments, 21 directors, one municipality and one county. The report also identifies 1,565 league teams and \$162,682 in League Calculated Team Entry Fees.

Calculated Team Entry Fees are analytical estimates, not verified receipts. They are based on participating teams multiplied by the publicly posted team entry fee. They do not, by themselves, establish actual collections, facility or municipal revenue, director compensation, profit, taxable income, bank deposits, gate/concession revenue, or disposition of funds.

The direct director chart is led by Matt Purser (approx. \$422.36K), Tony Taylor (\$360.55K), Wes Williams (\$356.08K), Scott Marwitz (\$296.91K), BIG Show Productions (\$188.73K), and Missy Jennings (\$150.39K). These values describe records associated with the named directors and do not establish personal receipt of the calculated amounts.

The highest specifically identified annual total season is **2021 at approximately \$258.07K**. The chart also contains an aggregated **Others** category of \$342.64K, which is not a single season. Baseball peaks in 2021 at approximately \$191.03K. Softball peaks in 2022 at approximately \$133.56K, followed closely by 2025 at \$131.57K.

The total, baseball and softball charts do not display identical year categories. The values above preserve the chart labels as shown rather than inventing unshown years.

Association is not allocation. Each amount is one pool of Calculated Team Entry Fee activity associated with the complete listed facility configuration. The report does not establish how teams, games, officials, fees, or other activity were distributed among the individual locations.

The Page 3 director chart is led by Rick Glasser (approx. \$281.58K) and BIG Show Productions (\$156.38K), followed by TJ Millus (\$47.50K), Tony Taylor (\$21.45K), Matt Purser (\$14.05K), Wally Fortuna (\$5.83K), Jimmy Greer (\$2.60K), and Wes Williams (\$2.52K).

Page 4 combines Pages 1-2 direct activity with Page 3 associated multi-facility activity. It is the broadest documented activity footprint involving Buck Thomas Park, not a claim that every dollar, team, game, or official occurred exclusively at the park.

The combined director chart is led by Matt Purser (approx. \$436.41K), Tony Taylor (\$382.00K), Wes Williams (\$358.60K), BIG Show Productions (\$345.12K), Scott Marwitz (\$296.91K), and Rick Glasser (\$295.24K). Moore is the dominant municipality grouping in the combined chart at approximately \$2.24M.

The combined footprint reaches 38 facility categories/combinations, 28 municipality groupings and 19 counties, illustrating the broad multi-site network associated with events that included Buck Thomas Park.

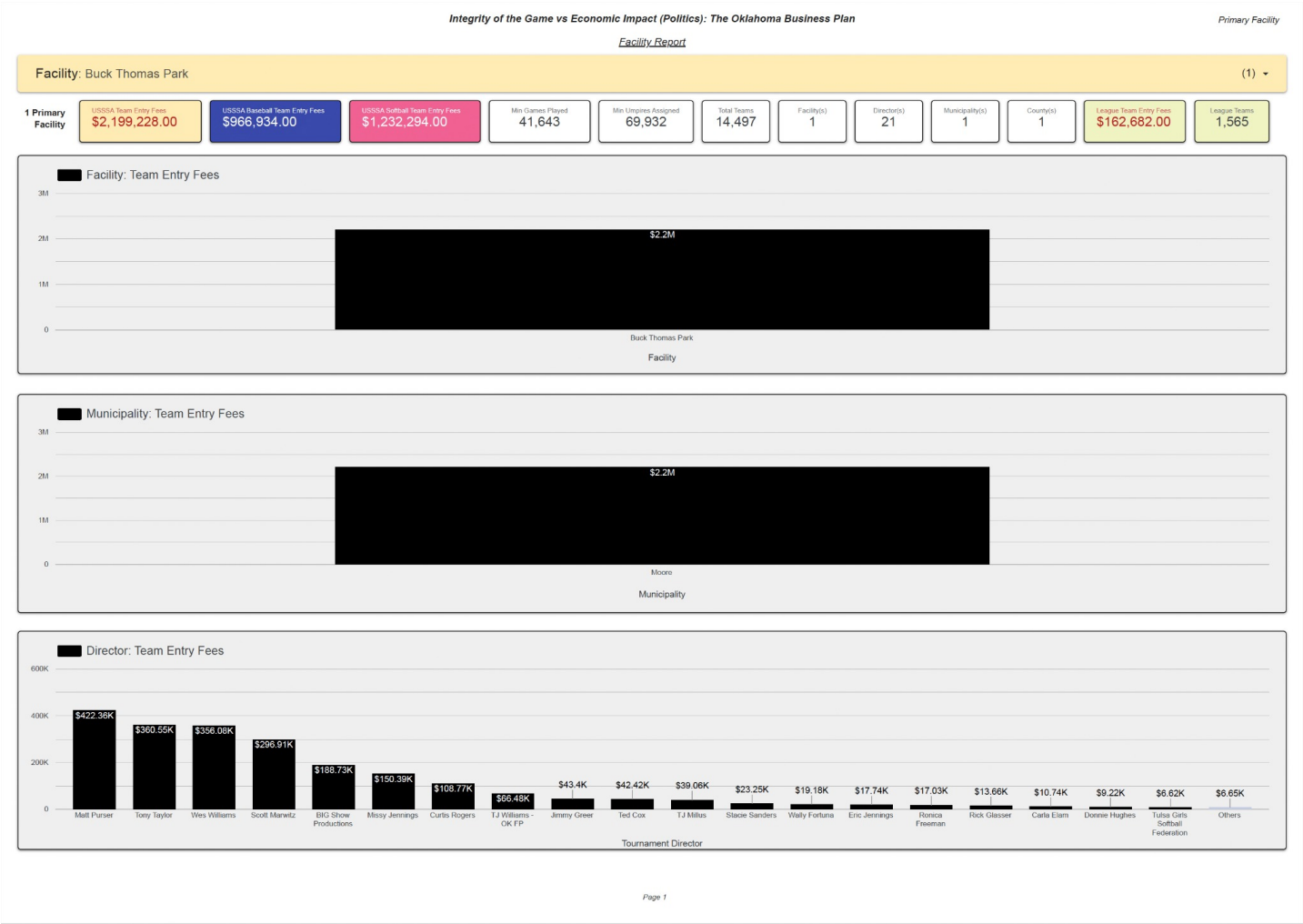
Methodology & Evidentiary Limits

The Facility Report separates direct Primary Facility records from multi-facility records specifically to avoid attributing every multi-site event entirely to one location. Separate facility reports should not simply be added together to calculate statewide totals because the same multi-facility event may appear in more than one facility report; statewide aggregation requires event-level deduplication.

The Hidden Valley dataset is an independent research reconstruction based primarily on publicly accessible USSSA event, tournament, league, director, facility, team, pricing and related historical information. Historical records may contain missing fields, naming variations, reused or inconsistent identifiers, facility-name changes, zero-dollar listings, or records later modified or removed.

This research is not an official USSSA report, audit, tax determination, forensic-accounting conclusion, or legal finding. Identification of an individual, organization, facility, municipality, tribe, school district, or other entity does not itself imply wrongdoing, misconduct, tax noncompliance, criminal activity, or civil liability.
