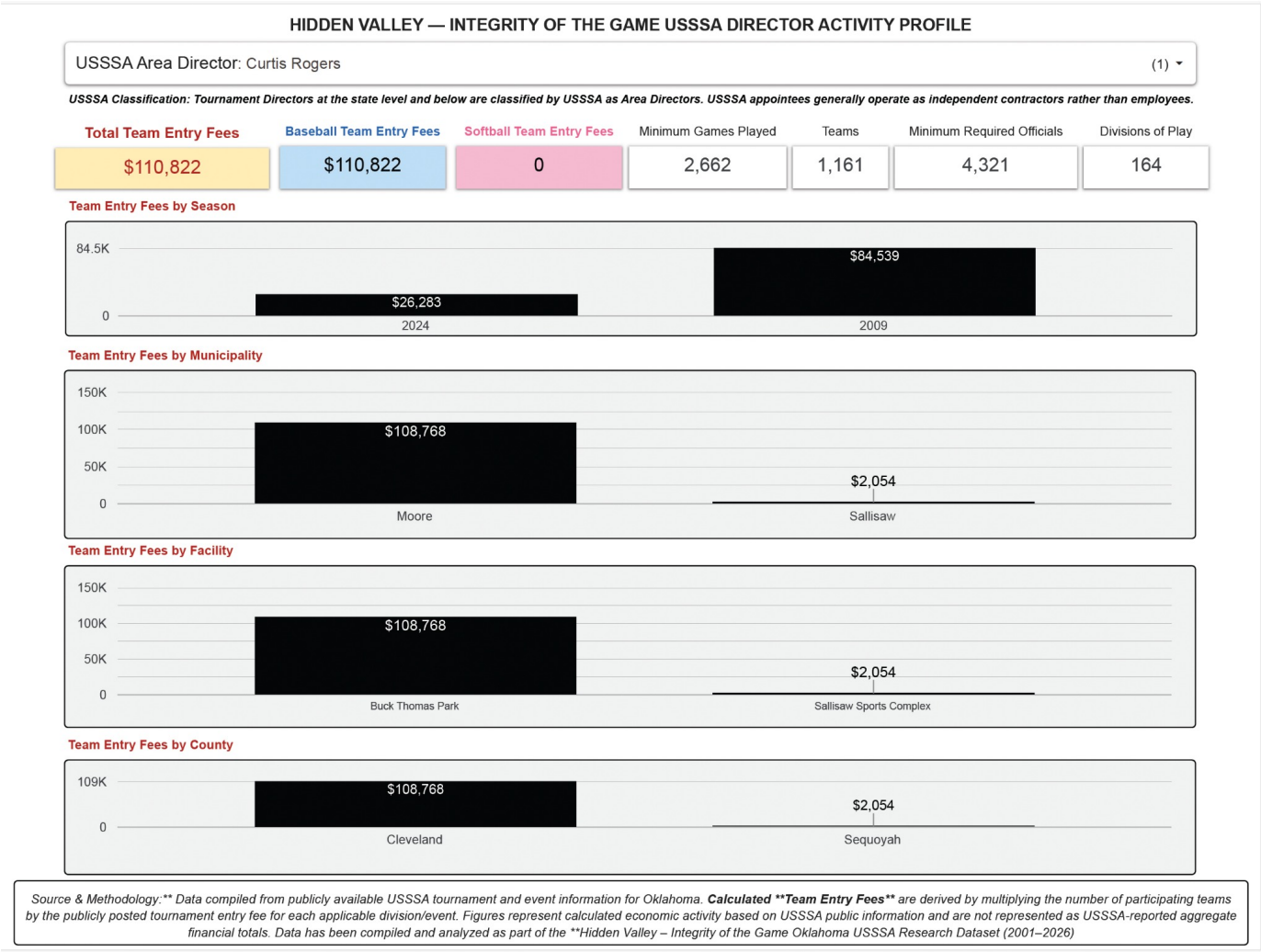

Hidden Valley - Integrity of the Game | Oklahoma USSSA Research Dataset (2001-2026)



Executive Summary

The updated source set documents Curtis Rogers activity in two reported seasons, 2009 and 2024, and across two Oklahoma municipalities, facilities, and counties. The calculated team-entry-fee total is \$110,822: \$84,539 in 2009 and \$26,283 in 2024. By location, \$108,768 is associated with Moore / Buck Thomas Park / Cleveland County and \$2,054 with Sallisaw / Sallisaw Sports Complex / Sequoyah County. All calculated entry-fee activity shown in the supplied profile is baseball; the profile reports \$0 in softball team entry fees.

Interpretation: The supplied data show a highly concentrated facility footprint: approximately 98.1% of calculated team entry fees are tied to Buck Thomas Park in Moore. The 2009 season accounts for approximately 76.3% of the calculated entry-fee total. These are descriptive characteristics of the supplied dataset, not findings about income, profit, ownership of funds, or legal/tax liability.

What the Event-Level Table Adds

The facility report contains 26 event/date rows. Several rows carry a \$0 calculated team-entry-fee value, while positive-value rows range from \$240 to \$11,572. The event table is useful because it preserves the date, sport, county, municipality, facility, director attribution, and calculated fee value rather than relying only on aggregate totals.

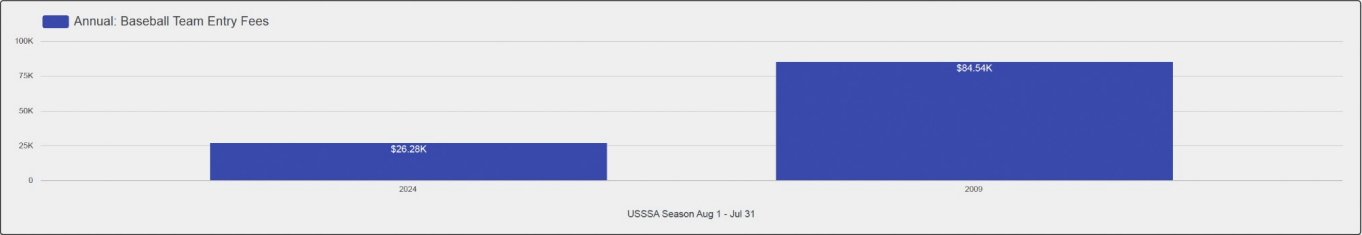
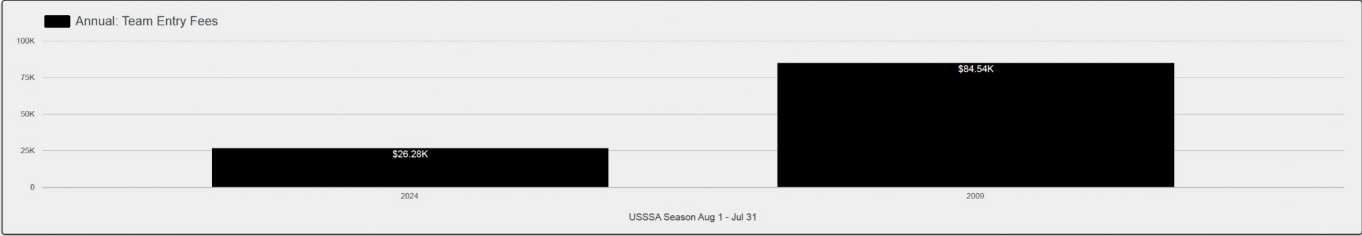

The event-level source page identifies 18 rows in 2009 and 8 rows in 2024. The 2024 Sallisaw entry is dated March 30, 2024 and carries a calculated team-entry-fee value of \$2,054; the remaining displayed 2024 activity is associated with Moore.

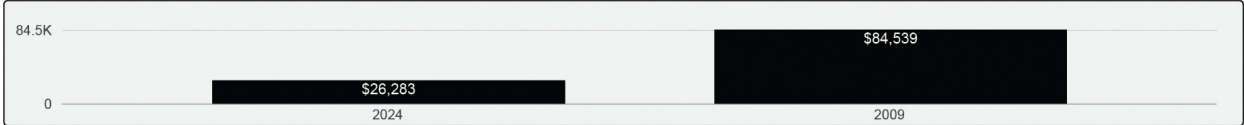

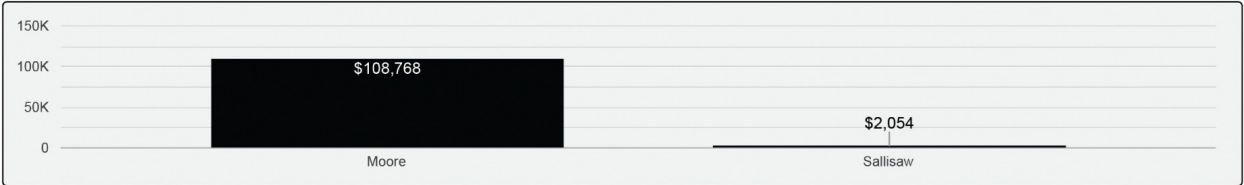
USSSA Classification: Tournament Directors at the state level and below are classified by USSSA as Area Directors. USSSA appointees generally operate as independent contractors rather than employees.

Team Entry Fees by County

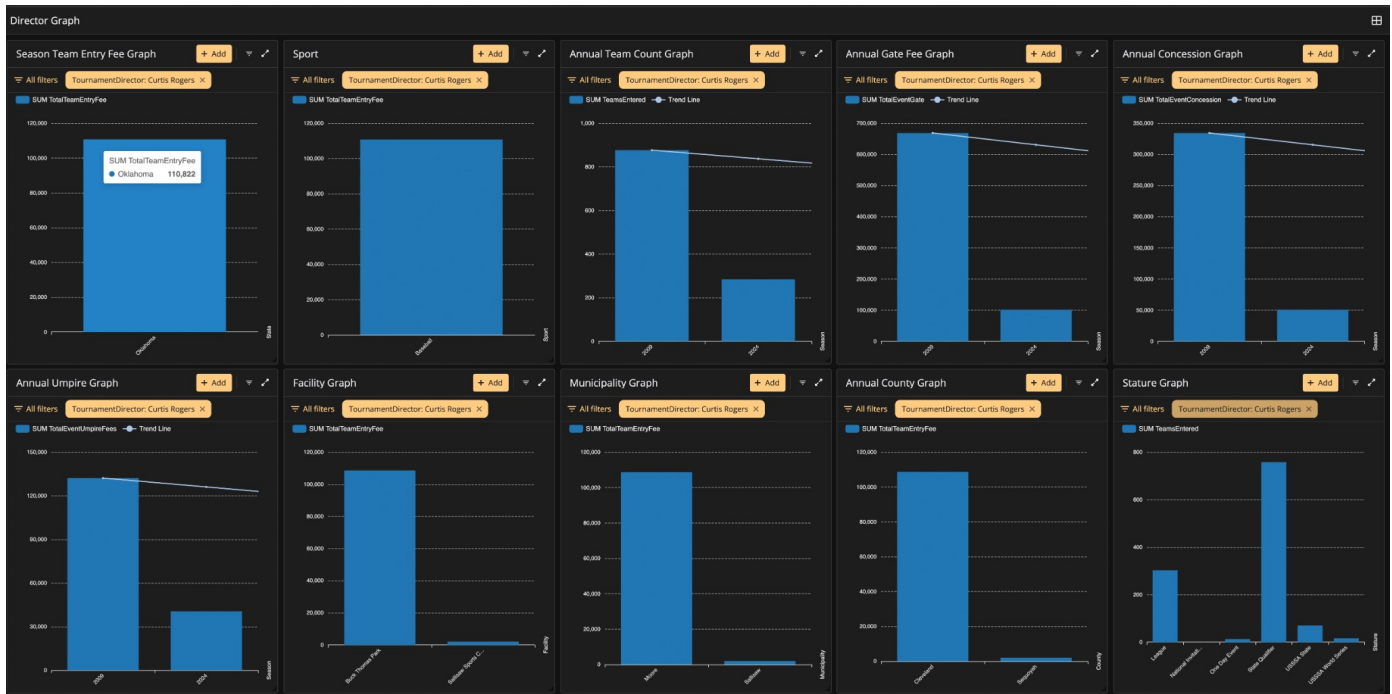
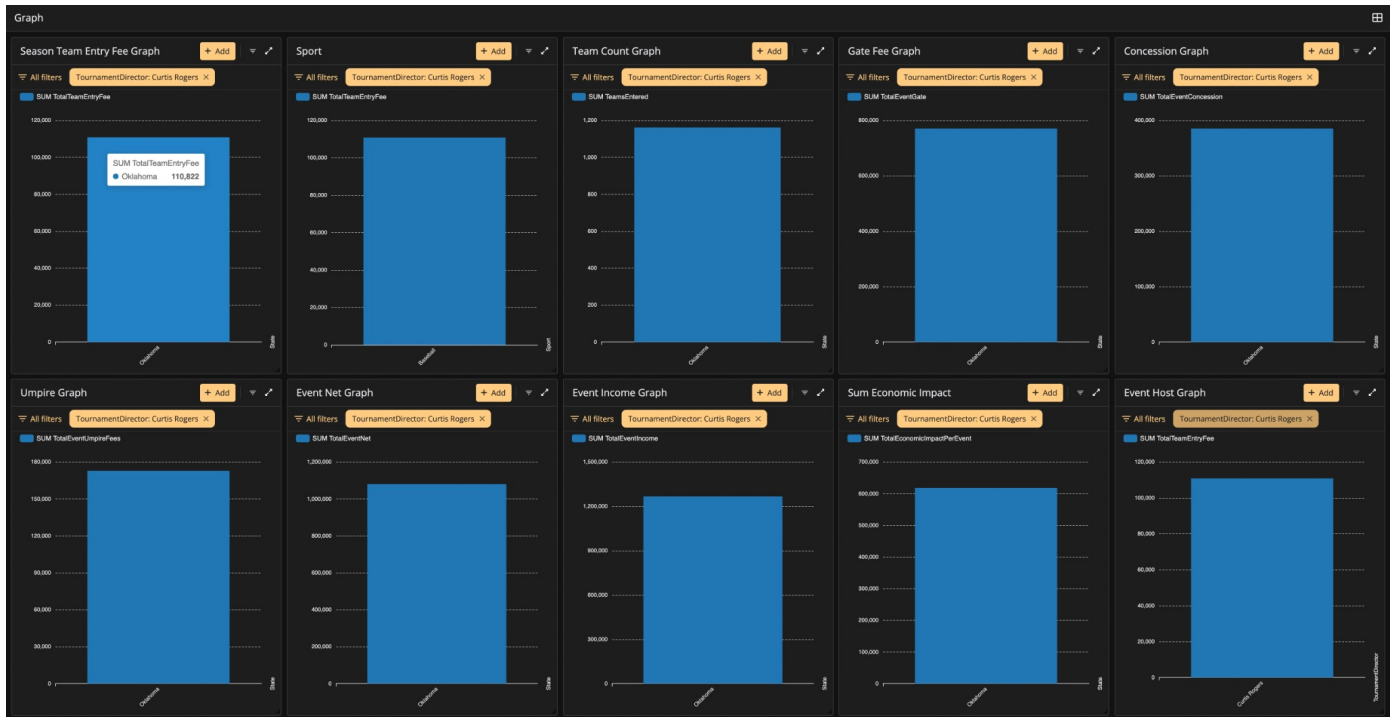

Figures represent calculated economic activity based on USSSA public information and are not represented as USSSA-reported aggregate financial totals. Data has been compiled and analyzed as part of the **Hidden Valley – Integrity of the Game Oklahoma USSSA Research Dataset (2001–2026)**



Expanded Research Modeling

The additional supplied dashboard screenshots extend beyond calculated team entry fees into modeled team counts, gate fees, concessions, umpire fees, event net, event income, economic impact, event-host views, annual trends, facility/municipality/county views, and stature categories. Because the screenshots do not expose all underlying formulas and exact numeric labels at readable precision, this report treats those panels as research-model views and does not convert their plotted heights into new audited or exact financial claims.



Research Findings & Methodology

- Documented scope: 1,161 teams, 164 divisions, 2,662 minimum games, 4,321 minimum required officials, two facilities, two municipalities, and two counties.
- Calculated entry fees: \$110,822 total, entirely classified as baseball in the supplied profile; no softball calculated team entry fees are shown.
- Season pattern: \$84,539 is attributed to 2009 and \$26,283 to 2024.
- Geographic pattern: \$108,768 is attributed to Moore / Buck Thomas Park / Cleveland County and \$2,054 to Sallisaw / Sallisaw Sports Complex / Sequoyah County.
- Important limitation: Calculated team entry fees are research estimates derived from public participation and posted entry-fee information. They should not be interpreted as USSSA-reported aggregate revenue, director income, profit, taxable income, audited financial statements, or proof of who ultimately retained funds.

Research Use and Evidentiary Caution

This profile is best used as a structured activity map for further records research: it identifies where and when publicly visible tournament activity occurred and quantifies the research dataset's calculated entry-fee values. Questions concerning payment ownership, refunds, discounts, cancellations, facility agreements, operating costs, compensation, tax treatment, or ultimate disposition of funds require independent source records and should not be inferred from these dashboards alone.
