ORDINANCE NO. 1080NS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBERED 763NS LEVYING AND ASSESSING AN ADDITIONAL ONE PERCENT (1%) SALES TAX ON THE GROSS RECEIPTS OR PROCEEDS DERIVED FROM CERTAIN SALES; PROVIDING THE PURPOSE OF SAID ADDITIONAL SALES TAX; FIXING EFFECTIVE DATE AND DATE OF TERMINATION; PROVIDING FOR SUCH RECEIPTS TO BE PLACED IN A SPECIAL EXCLUSIVE ACCOUNT; MAKING PROVISIONS SEVERABLE; CONTAINING OTHER PROVISIONS RELATING THERETO; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SHAWNEE, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS. The definitions of words, terms and phrases contained in the Oklahoma Sales Tax Code, Title 68, Oklahoma Statutes 1981, Section 1301 and following are hereby adopted by reference and made a part of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. Subject to approval of a majority of the registered voters of said City of Shawnee, Oklahoma, voting on same as prescribed by law, this Ordinance shall become and be effective on and after July 1, 1982.

SECTION 3. PURPOSE AND TERMINATION. Ordinance Number 763NS of the City of Shawnee is hereby amended by the addition of the following Section:

"ADDITIONAL 1¢ SALES TAX; PURPOSE; TERMINATION. It is hereby declared that the additional one percent (1%) sales tax levied by this Ordinance shall be in addition to the other sales tax levied by Ordinance Number 763NS and shall be used by the City or transferred to a public trust of which the City is the beneficiary to be used directly or indirectly for the following purposes, including the payment of debt service and other requirements that may be required by any document securing the payment of indebtedness incurred for such purposes or indebtedness incurred to refinance such indebtedness:

- (a) the Atoka water line tie in;
- (b) the water well system for the City;
- (c) participation in the North Deer Creek Reservoir project, including the payment for the purchase of water or any operation and maintenance expenses;
- (d) participation in the Pecan Bull Frog project; and

(e) payment of principal and interest requirements incurred by the Shawnee Interim Finance Authority incurred in connection with the acquisition and construction of the North Side and South Side sewage treatment plants and certain inteceptor lines;

PROVIDED THAT; the additional one percent (1%) sales tax provided for hereby shall terminate within thirty (30) days after the payment of all bonds or notes issued by any public trust with the City as beneficiary for such purposes or any bonds or notes issued by such trust to refinance said bonds or notes initially issued; PROVIDED FURTHER, that upon receipt of such sales tax revenue, the City Treasurer shall cause to be transferred to a special account an amount equal to such revenues to be used exclusively for such purposes."

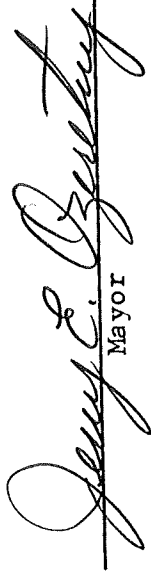
SECTION 4. The rate of tax set forth in Sales Tax Ordinance No. 763NS, of the City of Shawnee, Oklahoma, is hereby increased to three percent (3%).

SECTION 5. PROVISIONS SEVERABLE. The provisions hereof are hereby declared to be severable, and if any section, paragraph, sentence or clause of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or inoperative by any court of competent jurisdiction such decision shall not affect any other section, paragraph, sentence or clause hereof.

SECTION 6. EMERGENCY. Whereas it is immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Shawnee and the inhabitants thereof that said additional sales tax be levied for the purpose above set out and that the provisions of this Ordinance become operative immediately, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

ORDINANCE NO. 1081NS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CALLING AND HOLDING OF AN ELECTION IN THE CITY OF SHAWNEE, STATE OF OKLAHOMA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE REGISTERED, QUALIFIED VOTERS OF SAID CITY THE QUESTION OF AUTHORIZING AN ADDITIONAL ONE PERCENT (1%) SALES TAX AND PROVIDING FOR THE USE THEREOF; CONTAINING OTHER PROVISIONS RELATING THERETO; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SHAWNEE, OKLAHOMA:

Section 1. That the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized and directed to call a special election to be held in said City on the 25th day of May, 1982, for the purpose of submitting to the registered, qualified voters thereof the following Proposition:

PROPOSITION

"SHALL THE CITY OF SHAWNEE, STATE OF OKLAHOMA, APPROVE ORDINANCE NO. 1080NS AND LEVY AND ASSESS A CITY EXCISE TAX (SALES TAX) OF ONE PERCENT (1%) IN ADDITION TO ALL OTHER CITY AND STATE EXCISE TAXES LEVIED OR ASSESSED, UPON THE GROSS PROCEEDS OR GROSS RECEIPTS DERIVED FROM ALL SALES TO ANY PERSON TAXABLE UNDER THE SALES TAX LAW OF OKLAHOMA WHICH ONE PERCENT (1%) SALES TAX SHALL BE USED BY THE CITY OR ANY PUBLIC TRUST WITH THE CITY AS ITS BENEFICIARY FOR THE LIMITED PURPOSES AS SET OUT IN SAID ORDINANCE, INCLUDING THE PAYMENT OF DEBT SERVICE ON INDEBTEDNESS INCURRED FOR SUCH PURPOSES, SAID SALES TAX TO TERMINATE UPON THE FINAL PAYMENT OF INDEBTEDNESS ISSUED FOR SUCH PURPOSES, ALL AS MORE FULLY SET OUT IN SAID ORDINANCE?"

Section 2. That such call for said election shall be by the Mayor and the publication of this Ordinance at least ten (10) days prior to the date of the election; that the ballots shall set forth the Proposition to be voted upon substantially as set out in Section 1 hereof; the returns of said election shall be made to and canvassed by the County Election Board; the polls shall be opened at 7:00 o'clock A.M. and remain open continuously until and be closed at 7:00 o'clock P.M.; and the number and location of the polling places and the persons who shall conduct such election shall be as follows:
