Updated Research Basis

This publication is rebuilt from the newly supplied Marie Gassaway USSSA director and facility reports. For the forthcoming landing-page update, these figures are intended to replace the older Marie Gassaway data rather than be blended with it.

Executive Summary

The updated profile documents **9,300 teams** across **1,436 divisions of play**, with **20,010 minimum games played** and **36,063 minimum required officials**. Calculated team entry fees total **\$1,688,211**: **\$1,644,080** baseball (97.4%) and **\$44,131** softball (2.6%).

The facility report identifies **31 facilities**, **26 municipalities**, and **15 counties**. Love Hatbox Field is the largest listed facility at **\$957,781**, followed by Tulsa Hilti Park at **\$643,954**. Together they represent approximately **94.9%** of the profile's calculated team entry fees.

At the municipality level, Muskogee is listed at **\$957,781** and Tulsa at **\$648,347**. At the county level, Muskogee County is listed at **\$960,091** and Tulsa County at **\$688,622**. The supplied dashboard also reports **941 league teams** and **\$10,165** in league team entry fees.

What the New Profile Shows

The revised data shows a highly concentrated documented footprint. Muskogee/Love Hatbox and Tulsa/Tulsa Hilti account for most of the calculated entry-fee activity, while the remaining facilities and municipalities form a substantially smaller long tail. This is a descriptive finding about the compiled event records, not a conclusion about ownership or ultimate disposition of funds.

Methodology Boundary

Calculated Team Entry Fees are analytical estimates derived from publicly reported team participation multiplied by the posted entry fee applicable to the corresponding tournament, event, or division. They should not be interpreted as USSSA-reported aggregate revenue, director income, profit, taxable income, or audited financial statements.

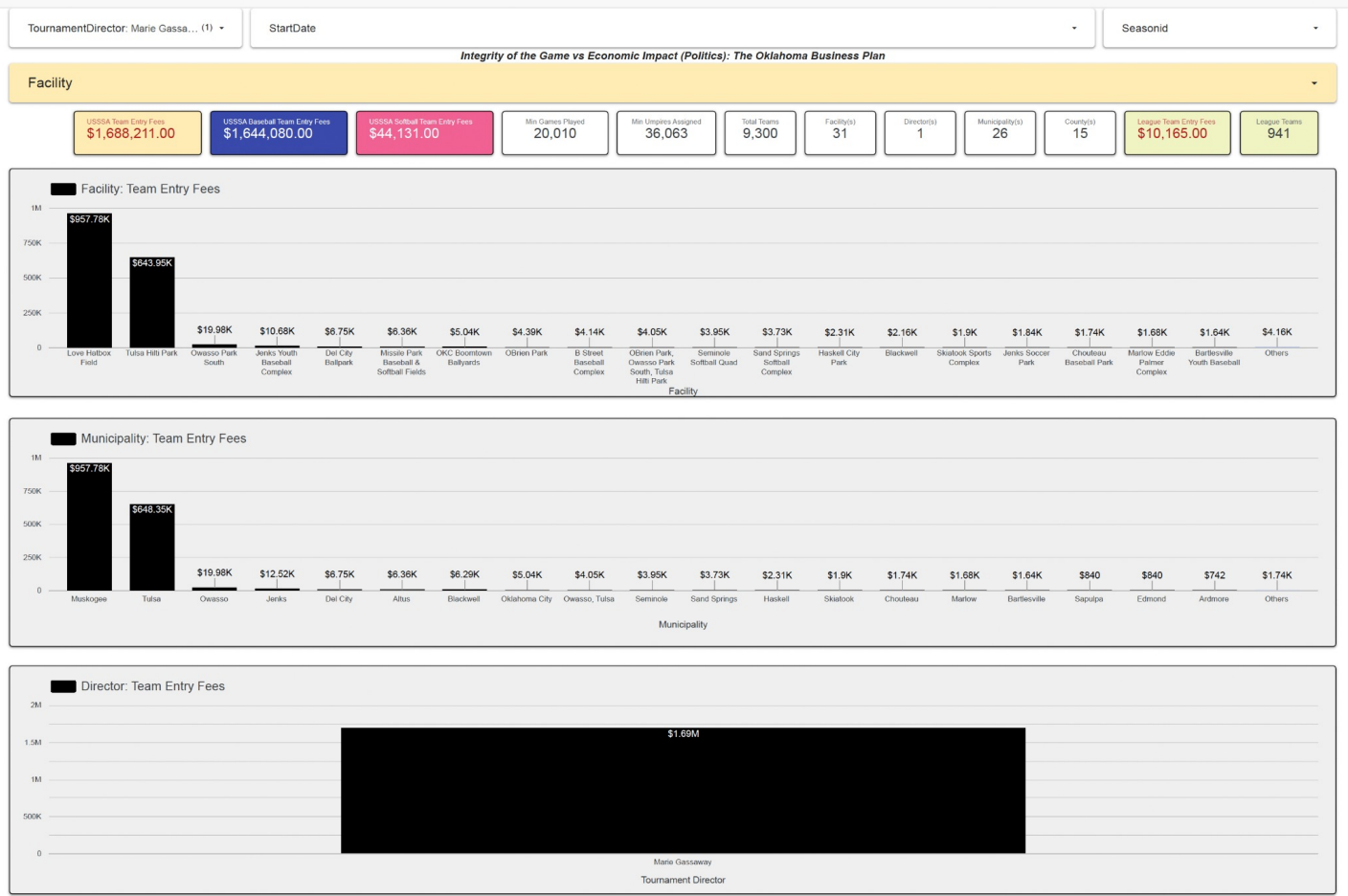

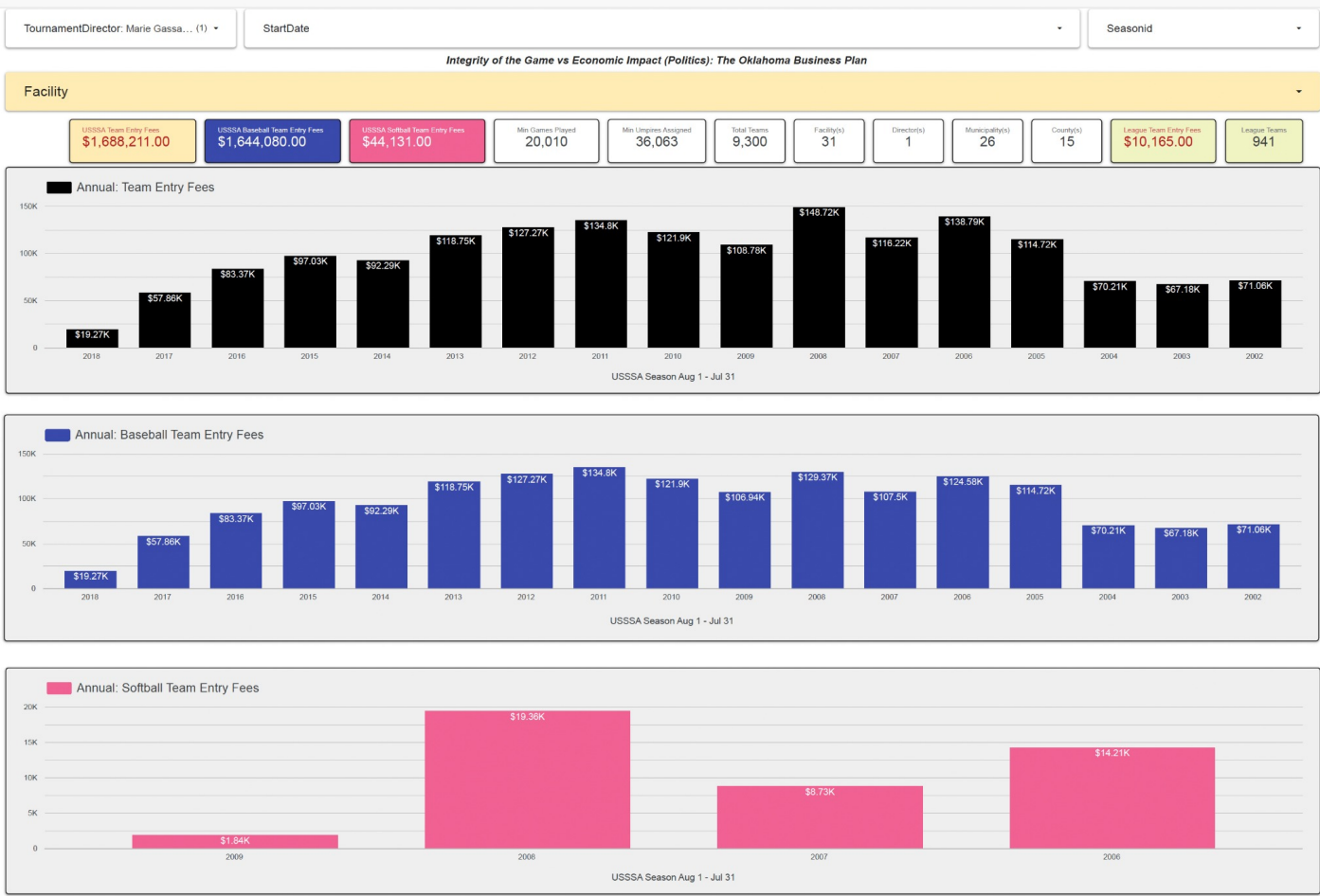

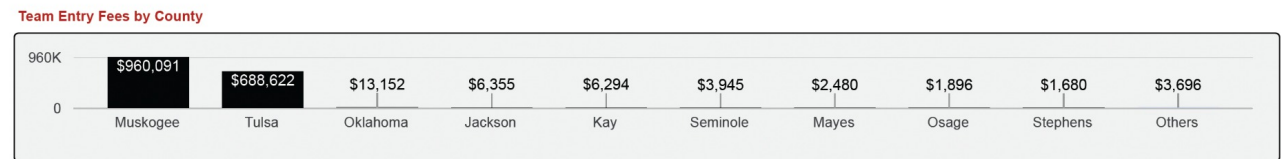

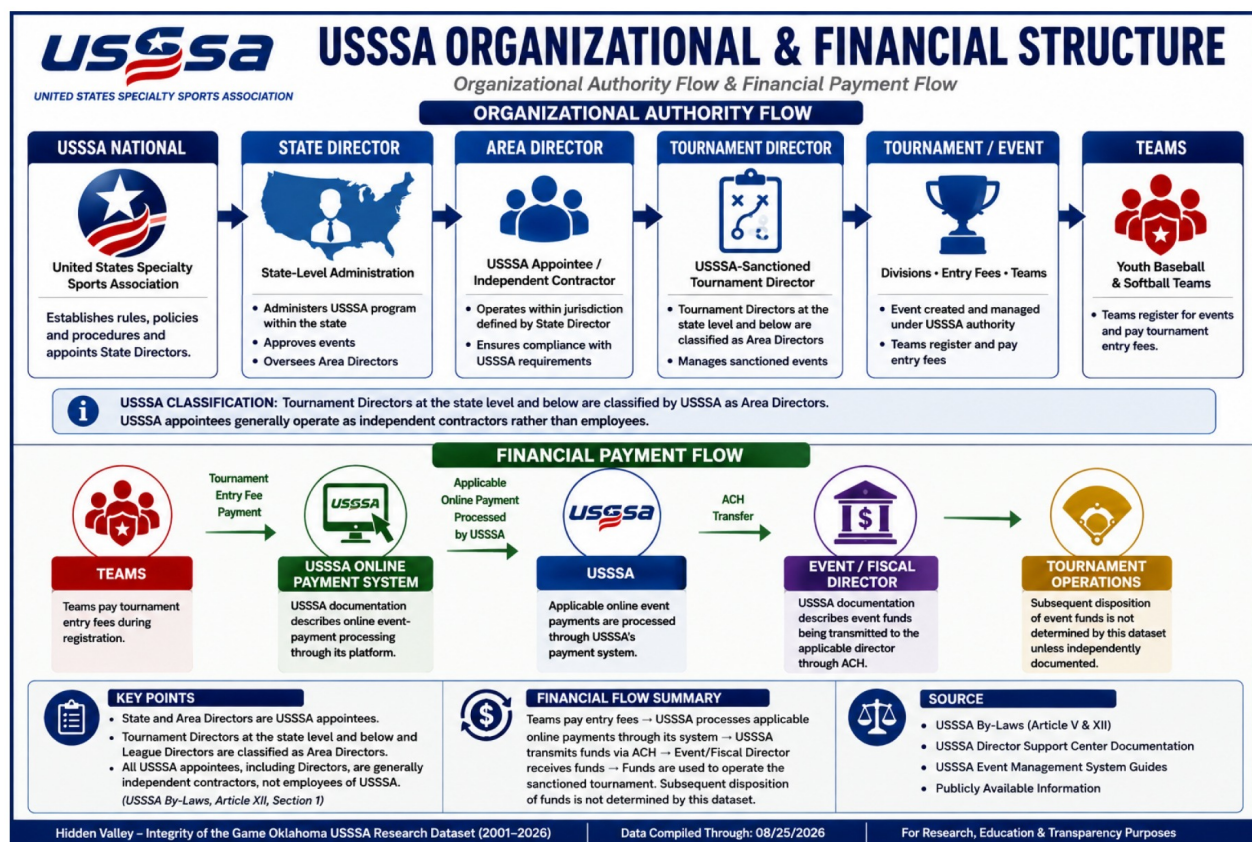
