Primary Facility: Midwest City MAC (Multi-Athletic Complex) | **Location:** 9400 SE 29th St., Midwest City, Oklahoma

Executive finding. Stand-alone records document **\$121,073** in Calculated Team Entry Fees, 380 teams, at least 1,029 games and 2,058 umpire assignments. Adding associated multi-facility records produces a combined documented footprint of **\$676,093**, 1,799 teams, 5,380 minimum games and 10,698 minimum umpire assignments. These are calculated/documented activity measures, not proof of facility revenue, municipal receipts, director income, profit, or allocation of multi-site funds.

1. Facility Context

The supplied history describes the MAC as a state-of-the-art multi-sport facility developed as a regional sports-tourism asset. Midwest City voters approved the \$21.6 million "Moving Forward" General Obligation Bond in August 2018, with roughly \$7 million designated for initial MAC design and construction. Construction broke ground in January 2021; Phase I opened April 22, 2022 with three all-turf modular fields, canopied seating, a playground and food-truck court. A 2023 Phase II expansion added a centralized concession facility and parking. The history identifies a planned Phase III opening in spring 2027 intended to double existing field capacity.

2. Direct / Stand-Alone Activity

Pages 1-2 are the conservative facility-specific view: they include records listing Midwest City MAC independently and exclude multi-facility combinations. The municipality chart assigns this direct population to Midwest City. The director chart shows Rick Glasser at about \$85.25K, BIG Show Productions at about \$31.78K and Wally Fortuna at about \$4.05K in Calculated Team Entry Fee activity. These concentrations do not establish personal receipts or compensation.

The highest displayed direct total season is **2023 (~\$38.69K)**. Baseball peaks in **2026 (~\$33.78K)**. Softball appears in 2023 and 2024 and peaks in **2023 (~\$22.87K)**.

Page 3 excludes the stand-alone MAC population and examines events where the MAC appears with one or more additional locations.

Largest displayed configurations: Midwest City MAC + Reed Baseball Complex (~\$264.9K); Brian Crawford Memorial Sports Complex + Midwest City MAC (~\$48.17K); Brian Crawford Memorial Sports Complex + Firelake Ballfields + Midwest City MAC + Reed Baseball Complex (~\$27.58K); and Brian Crawford Memorial Sports Complex + Midwest City MAC + Reed Baseball Complex (~\$25.92K).

ASSOCIATION IS NOT ALLOCATION. Each multi-facility amount is one pool of calculated activity associated with the listed configuration. The report does not establish how teams, games, officials, entry fees or funds were divided among individual sites.

4. Combined Documented Activity Footprint

The combined facility chart is led by Midwest City MAC + Reed Baseball Complex (~\$264.9K), followed by stand-alone Midwest City MAC (~\$121.07K) and Brian Crawford Memorial Sports Complex + Midwest City MAC (~\$48.17K). The largest combined municipality concentration is Midwest City (~\$385.97K). Director concentrations are Rick Glasser (~\$401.61K), BIG Show Productions (~\$219.12K), Wally Fortuna (~\$46.82K), and OK USSSA Fastpitch State Office (~\$8.55K).

5. Methodology & Evidentiary Interpretation

Calculated Team Entry Fees are defined as **Number of Participating Teams x Publicly Posted Team Entry Fee**, calculated at the applicable event-record level and aggregated for analysis. If the public record displays a \$0.00 entry fee, the dataset records \$0.00 rather than imputing an unsupported fee. A zero-dollar listing does not necessarily mean no operational activity occurred.

Calculated Team Entry Fees do **not**, by themselves, establish actual collections, gross receipts, facility or municipal revenue, director compensation, profit, USSSA corporate revenue, bank deposits, taxable income, gate or concession revenue, umpire compensation, tax liability, or disposition of funds. Multi-facility records require additional documentation to determine allocation.

Separate facility reports also should not simply be summed into a statewide total because the same multi-facility event may appear in more than one facility report. Statewide aggregation requires event-level deduplication.

6. Independent Research Disclaimer

The Hidden Valley - Integrity of the Game dataset is an independent research reconstruction based primarily on publicly accessible USSSA event, tournament, league, director, facility, team, pricing and related historical information. Identified limitations include incomplete historical records, naming variations, reused or inconsistent identifiers, facility-name changes, zero-dollar listings, missing fields, and records that may later be modified or removed.

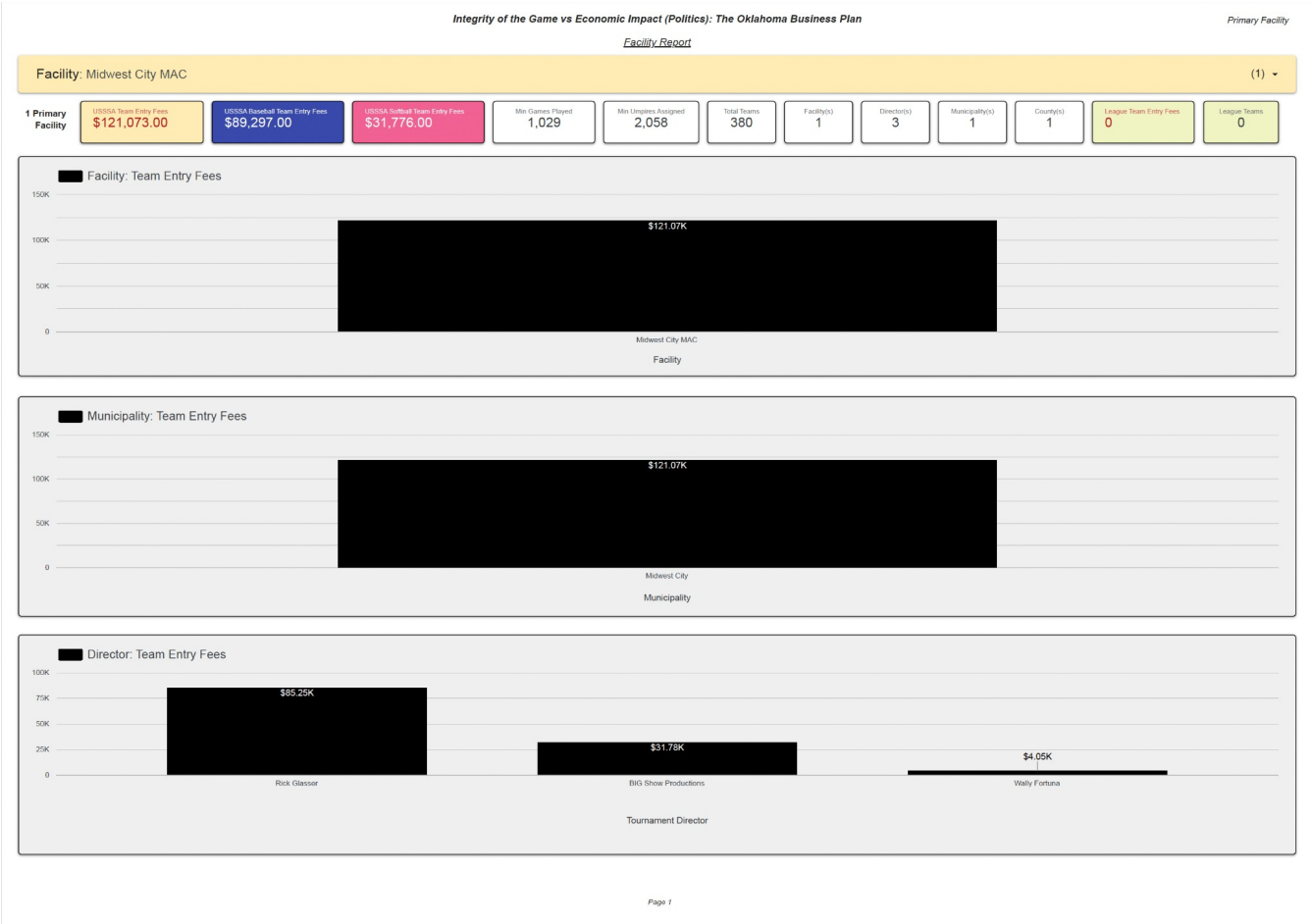

Facility-specific synthesis. Midwest City MAC shows a direct documented USSSA footprint of \$121,073 in Calculated Team Entry Fees across 380 teams, with baseball representing \$89,297 and softball \$31,776. The highest direct total season displayed is 2023. The broader associated multi-facility population adds \$555,020 in calculated activity, producing a combined documented footprint of \$676,093. The strongest multi-site relationship displayed is the Midwest City MAC + Reed Baseball Complex configuration. All multi-facility amounts must be interpreted under the report's controlling principle: association establishes involvement in the same event record, not allocation of the full event amount to each facility.
