Executive Summary

The updated statewide dataset identifies **\$36,516,991** in calculated Team Entry Fees across **166,964 team entries** and **20,305 division records**. It documents **430,060 minimum games played** and **786,896 minimum required officials**. Baseball represents **\$20,948,047** and softball **\$15,568,944**.

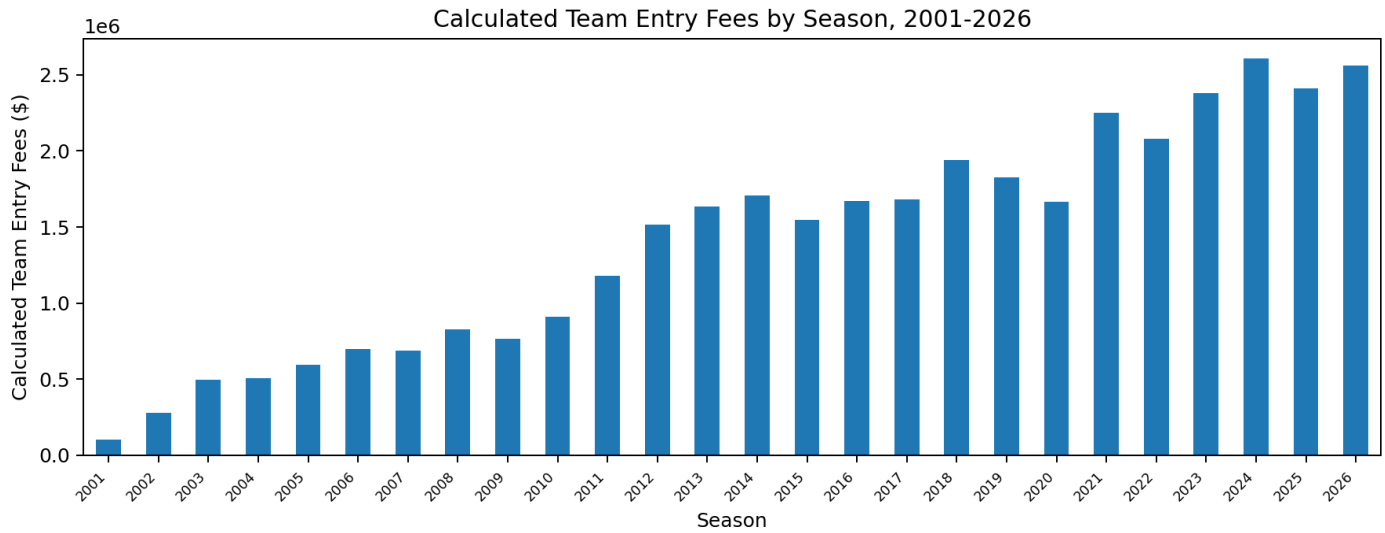
The September 14 update adds **\$177,361** in calculated Team Entry Fees, **1,752 team entries**, **5,826 minimum games**, and **9,327 minimum required officials**. The division-row count is 11 lower than the earlier summary, showing that the revision also changed or consolidated some underlying records rather than merely appending rows.

Methodology

Participating Teams x Publicly Posted Team Entry Fee = Calculated Team Entry Fees. These figures are calculated economic activity based on public USSSA event information. They are not represented as USSSA-reported aggregate revenue, director income, profit, taxable income, or audited financial statements.

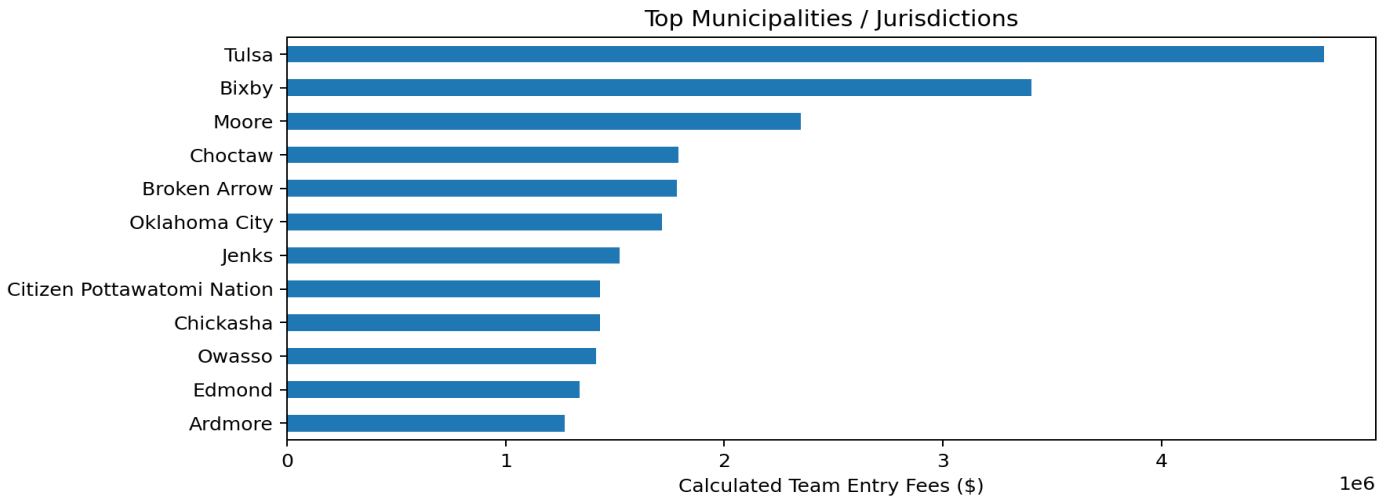
Season Findings

The largest season is **2024 at \$2,605,431**, followed by **2026 at \$2,562,323** and **2025 at \$2,411,275**. The series demonstrates long-run growth from the early 2000s into the modern tournament era, while retaining meaningful year-to-year variation.

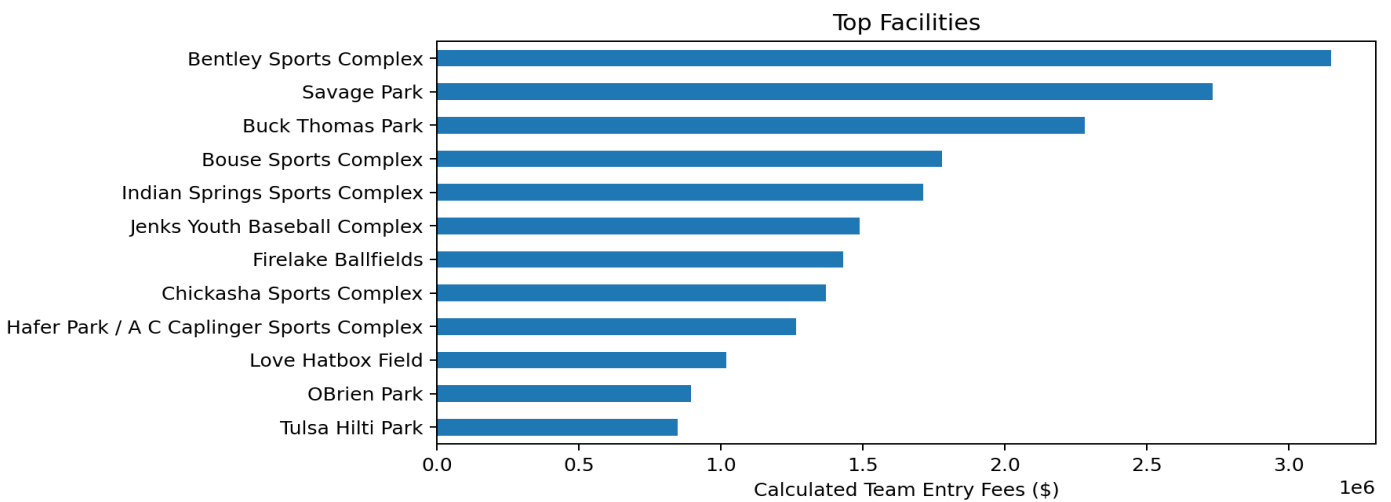
