Executive Facility Summary

The supplied history identifies the Putnam City Optimist (PCO) Girls Softball Complex, also known as PCO Girls Park, as a dedicated youth girls' fastpitch facility at 8601 NW 50th St., Oklahoma City. It states that the complex was established in 1974 by the Putnam City Optimist Club. The facility report separates stand-alone primary-facility activity from broader multi-facility event associations.

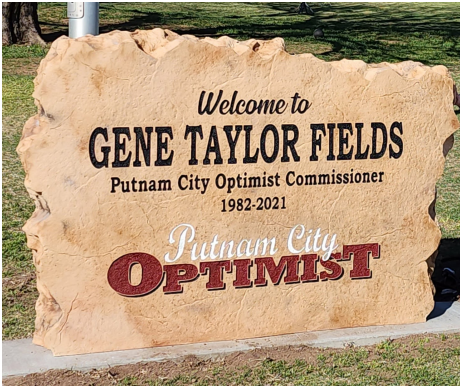

Key Findings

2026 annual activity: The direct annual charts display \$27,555 total Calculated Team Entry Fees, all identified as softball, with \$0 baseball activity. Because only one season is displayed, the report does not establish a multi-year stand-alone trend.

Multi-facility activity: Page 3 identifies \$145,547 in calculated softball team entry-fee activity across records combining PCO with other locations. The largest displayed combinations are approximately \$60.45K, \$32.57K, \$29.64K, \$18.72K, and \$4.18K. These are combination-level amounts and must not be assigned in full to each individual facility.

Combined documented footprint: Page 4 combines direct and associated records for \$173,102 in Calculated Team Entry Fees, all softball, involving 253 teams, at least 880 games, 1,760 umpire assignments, six facilities, six municipalities, four counties, and one tournament-director label.



Historical Context

The supplied history states that PCO began in **1974** with **26 teams** under first commissioner Russ Wyman. It reports that the PCO-based OKC Jets won the ASA 18-and-under national championship in 1979.

Gene Taylor became the park's second commissioner in **1982**. The history describes close to **100 teams** and more than **1,200 games each summer** by the mid-1980s, and states that 48 girls had advanced to college softball by 1986. The supplied monument identifies the playing area as **Gene Taylor Fields** and recognizes Taylor as commissioner from 1982-2021.

Methodology & Evidentiary Boundary

Association is not allocation. Calculated Team Entry Fees equal participating teams multiplied by the publicly posted team entry fee at the applicable event-record level. The report does not, by itself, establish actual collections, gross receipts, facility or municipal revenue, director compensation, profit, bank deposits, tax liability, gate or concession revenue, or how multi-facility activity was distributed among individual locations. The Hidden Valley dataset is an independent research reconstruction, not an official USSSA or governmental accounting record.
