Executive Summary

The refreshed source reports expand the documented Terri Jungels activity profile. Total Calculated Team Entry Fees increase to \$1,364,663, all categorized as baseball. The operational footprint now includes 9,337 teams, 1,272 divisions, 19,986 minimum games, and 34,653 minimum required officials. The updated facility report also identifies 1,115 league teams associated with \$41,037 in League Team Entry Fees.

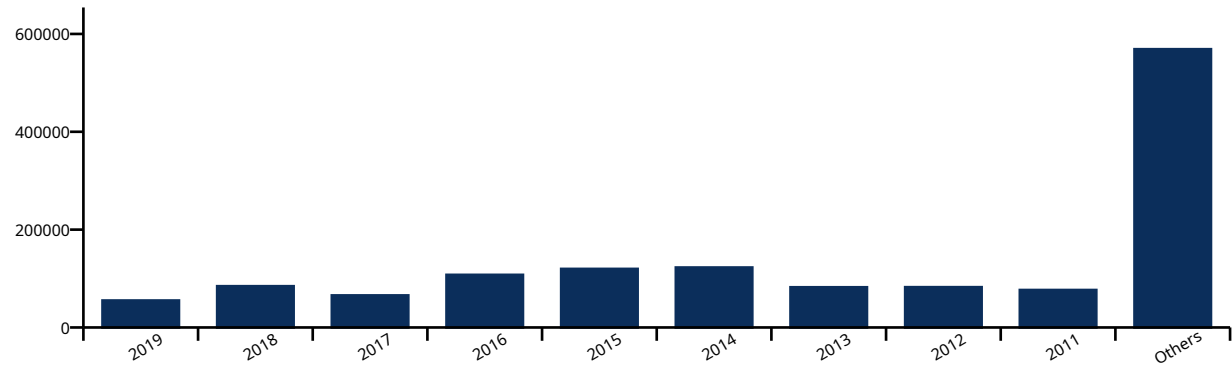
Scope and interpretation

The revision is concentrated in three displayed seasons: 2017 (+\$474), 2018 (+\$21,258), and 2019 (+\$1,842). Together these changes equal the full \$23,574 increase in the profile total. Among individually displayed seasons, 2014 remains the largest at \$122,553; the aggregated "Others" category remains \$568,796.

The facility report also displays annual bars from 2002 through 2019, giving a more granular historical view than the condensed director-summary chart. The exact aggregate remains \$1,364,663.

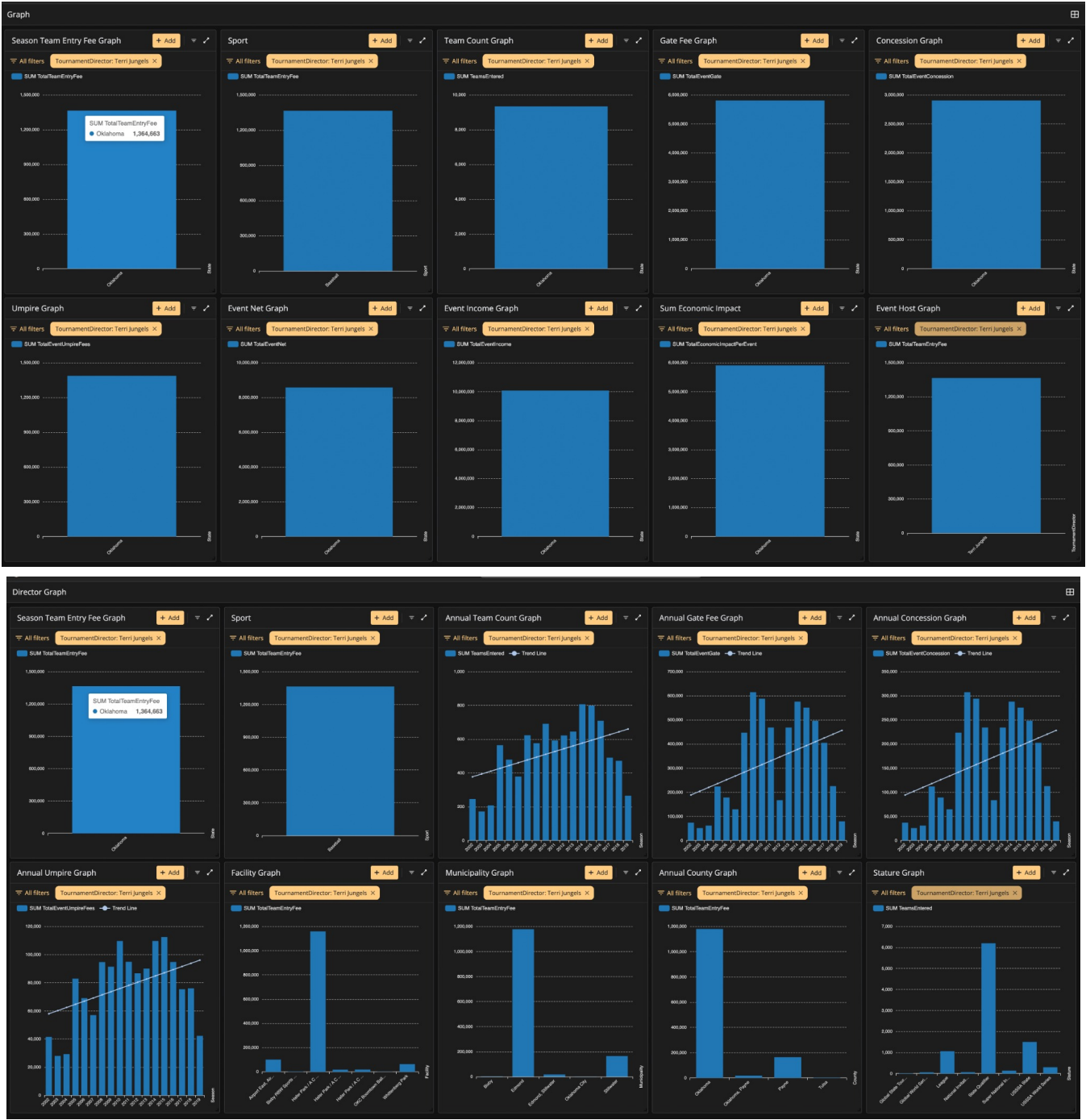

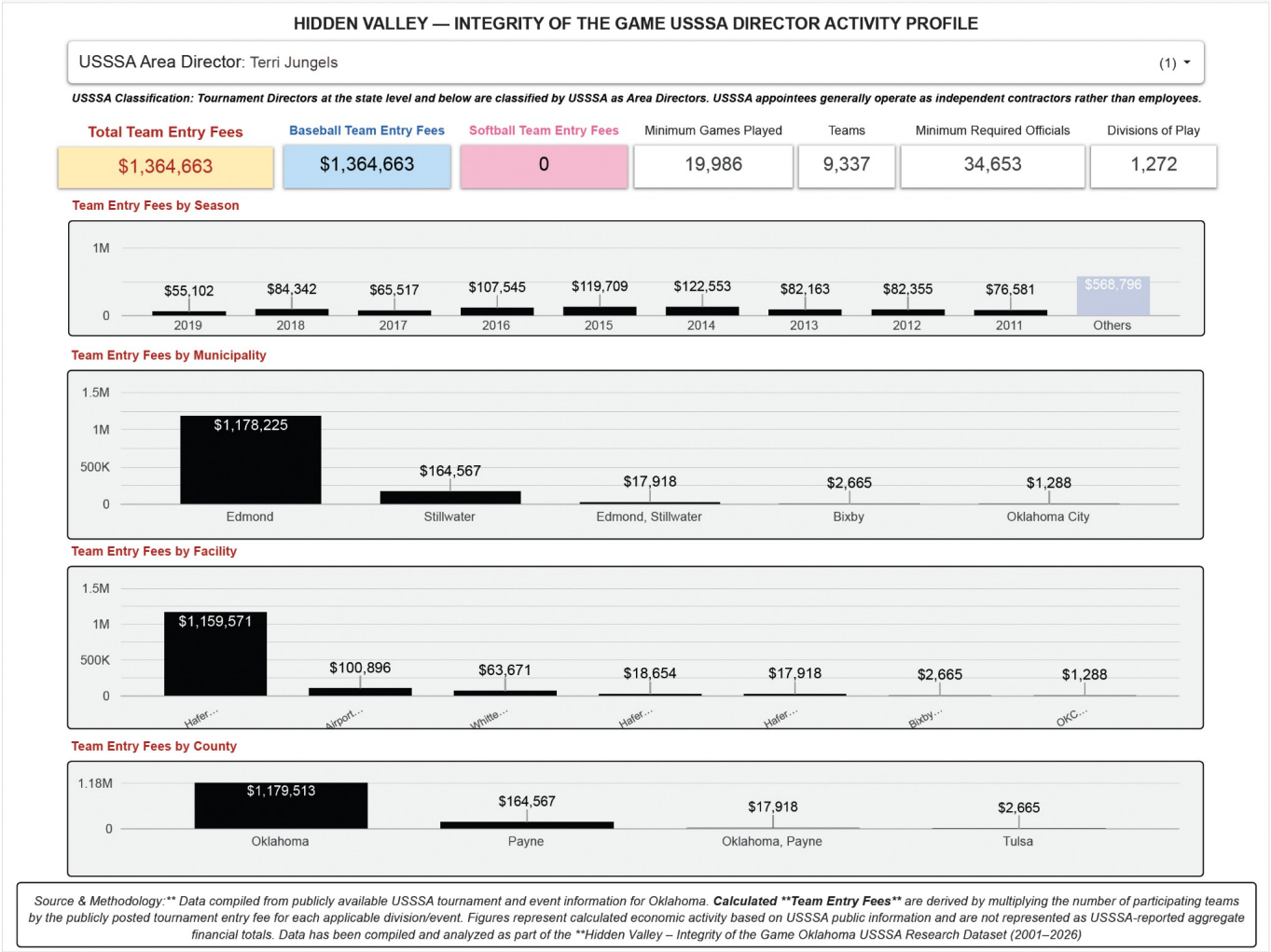
The updated profile reinforces the same geographic pattern identified previously: Edmond / Oklahoma County is the dominant concentration, followed by Stillwater / Payne County. The revised source displays the principal Hafer Park / A C Caplinger Sports Complex classification at \$1,159,571. Multi-location classifications are preserved as combined records and should not be duplicated in full across each named location.

Expanded Operational Modeling - Source Dashboards

The newly supplied dashboard images extend the profile beyond the core entry-fee summary. They show modeled views for team counts, gate fees, concessions, umpire fees, event net, event income, economic impact, host activity, annual trends, facility, municipality, county, and organizational stature. Because these dashboard screenshots do not expose exact underlying values for every modeled measure, this summary does not convert bar heights into unsupported precise totals.

Methodology, Organizational Context and Research Limits



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The supplied organizational/financial-flow page is explanatory context rather than a Terri Jungels-specific finding about receipt or disposition of funds. It depicts an organizational authority chain and an applicable online payment pathway, while expressly cautioning that ownership of funds, individual compensation, tax liability, legal liability, and ultimate disposition of tournament proceeds are not established by the dataset alone.

Research conclusion

The refreshed record supports a larger documented activity footprint than the prior profile: +\$23,574 in Calculated Team Entry Fees, +226 teams, +487 minimum games, and +818 minimum required officials, with divisions unchanged. The update also adds explicit league scorecards and broader modeled operational dashboards. These additions strengthen the activity-profile analysis while preserving the distinction between calculated economic activity and verified revenue, compensation, profit, or fund disposition.

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
