Executive Overview

The updated Wes Williams profile materially expands the activity captured in the earlier report. The supplied director and facility reports now display **\$464,163 in Calculated Team Entry Fees**, all categorized as softball, together with **3,777 teams, 13,497 minimum games played, 22,314 minimum required officials**, and **372 divisions of play**. The updated facility report also separately identifies **614 league teams** and **\$36,677 in league Calculated Team Entry Fees**.

The central analytical change is not merely a higher financial estimate: the new records add 901 teams and substantially increase the documented operational footprint. The profile therefore should be treated as an activity profile combining calculated financial measurement, event/league participation, facility use, geographic concentration, games, and minimum officiating requirements.

Interpretive note: Calculated Team Entry Fees are derived from public team participation multiplied by the publicly posted entry fee. They are not USSSA-reported aggregate revenue, director income, profit, taxable income, or audited financial statements.

Updated Seasonal Activity

The updated reports preserve the same nine displayed seasons but materially revise the 2018 and 2019 activity. Most notably, 2019 now displays \$37,816 rather than \$0, and 2018 increases to \$80,387.

Largest displayed season: 2015 remains the peak at \$93,881. The revised 2017 and 2018 seasons are both above \$80,000, while the newly recovered 2019 activity adds \$37,816.

The updated profile remains highly concentrated in the Moore - Buck Thomas Park - Cleveland County corridor. Each independently displayed primary dimension now carries \$436,453. Combined-location records are retained as single activity pools and should not be duplicated across every named municipality, facility, or county.

Operational Scale and Newly Visible League Activity

The new facility report adds an important distinction between overall captured activity and league activity. It displays 614 league teams and \$36,677 in league Calculated Team Entry Fees. These league figures are components of the broader profile and should not be added again to the \$464,163 total unless an underlying record review establishes that they are outside that total.

The updated totals imply a large officiating workload: 22,314 minimum required official assignments across at least 13,497 games. These are minimum operational measures derived from the research model; they are not payroll records and do not establish who officiated, how much any individual was paid, or whether all scheduled games were completed.

Supplemental Economic-Activity Dashboard

The supplied dark-theme dashboard expands the analytical model beyond Team Entry Fees. It presents modeled categories for event gate, concessions, umpire fees, event income, event net, and economic impact. Because the dashboard images do not provide underlying transaction-level records in this packet, those categories should be presented as research-model estimates rather than verified receipts or disbursements. They are useful for scale and investigative prioritization, but they should remain analytically separate from the exact Calculated Team Entry Fee figures above.

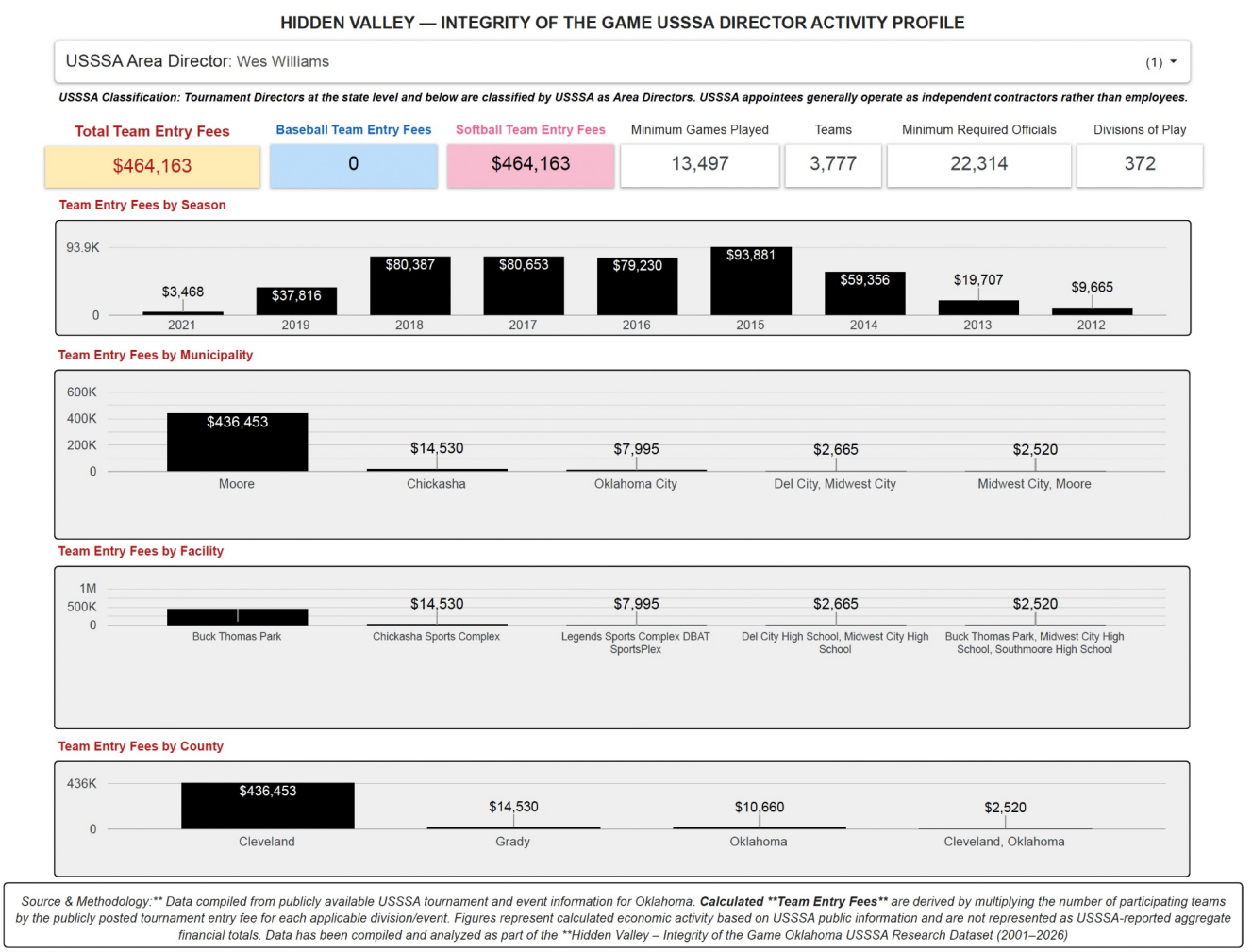

Director-Specific Summary

The updated Wes Williams profile displays \$464,163 in Total Calculated Team Entry Fees, all categorized as softball, with 3,777 teams, 372 divisions, 13,497 minimum games, and 22,314 minimum required officials. Compared with the prior profile, the newly recovered records increase Calculated Team Entry Fees by \$80,374 and teams by 901. The strongest concentration remains Moore, Buck Thomas Park, and Cleveland County at \$436,453 in each corresponding independently displayed dimension. The updated records also identify 614 league teams and \$36,677 in league Calculated Team Entry Fees, making league activity an explicit part of the profile's documented operating footprint.

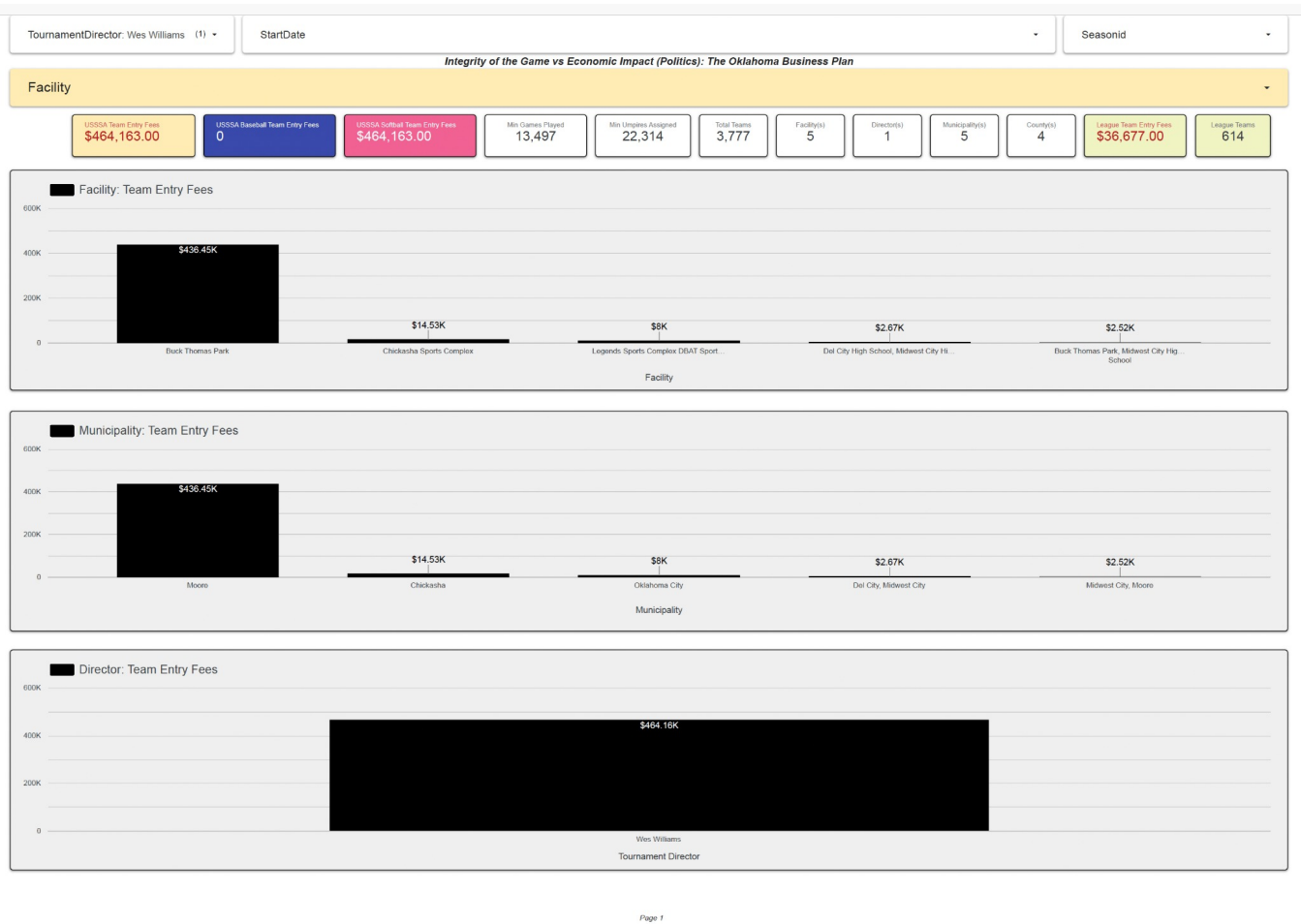
